

2016 Summer Prep Showcase Notes

Welcome to the 2016 Summer Prep Showcase basketball tournament hosted by Brian Jolivet/Houston Hoops. The Summer Prep is the 2nd of four(4) events we host annually:

- OFF DA HOOK, April 8-10
- Summer Prep, May 13-15
- June Jam, June 10-12
- Houston National Summer Showcase, July 5-7 (NCAA LIVE)

The Summer Prep is intended to provide great competition at all levels and prepare teams for the summer events. We hope you will have a memorable experience and attend the June Jam and HNSS.

We work extremely hard to host a 1st class event but the success of the event depends on the cooperation and commitment from the coaches and players. Please be aware of the following rules and key notes:

- Games are scheduled to last 1 hour and 5 minutes. Please arrive minimum of 30 minutes prior to game time and visit the check in table.
- At the time of check in you will receive a roster sheet to complete with players first & last name and number. Please keep your roster list for the entire weekend and provide your roster list to the scorekeeper prior to each game the entire weekend **(MAKE SURE THE SCOREKEEPER RETURN YOUR ROSTER LIST)**
- Each team is allowed two(2) coaching bands at no charge and the coach must sit on the bench.
- Each coach will receive a band to be worn the entire weekend and the coach must check in each day.
- Coaches and fans are expected to conduct themselves with respect and ABSOLUTELY NO VULGARITY. Failure to comply will result in dismissal from the event for the entire weekend.
- Each team will play two(2) pool games and advance to single elimination bracket play.
- Maximum points differential : + or - 15
- Some pools consist of four(4) teams and each team will play two(2) games resulting in some teams not playing each other. Should teams complete pool play with the same record the following rules will be used to determine tie breakers:
 - Head to head
 - Points differential
 - Points scored
 - Points allowed
- If a team suspects that a player is not eligible via grade and/or age the team reporting the potential infraction must pay a non-refundable fee in the amount of \$50 to the gym manager. The grievance must be filed prior to the start of the game. The coach of the team with the potential ineligible player must provide report card and birth certificate immediately. Failure to provide will result in player dismissal from the tournament.
