WELCOME TO TOYOTA OF LEWISVILLE RAILROAD PARK
 Opened in October 2009, Toyota of Lewisville Railroad Park was developed in one phase and is the largest single capital project in the history of Denton. The sprawling park features stadium soccer fields, a dog park, a skate park, three lakes for irrigation, and a 1.5 mile perimeter walking/jogging trail designed in concert to the regional Tri-County Trail.

The original Katy Train Depot once stood one mile north of the park and the railroad track just west of the park now serves the Denton County Transportation Authority's A-Train. The Densie of the park embodies the deep tradition of the local rail service, which is emphasized in the structures that parallel the design of the original Katy Depot. Rooms are placed near the main entrance and football pavilion to pay tribute to this heritage. The park continues to play a key role in the life of the surrounding community just as the Katy Depot and rail service did years ago.
