## "C DIVISION" ALLSTAR TOURNAMENT

## Official tournament rules

- 1) Check in at least one (1) hour before first game time. Check-in tables will be located in the center of all fields near the scoreboard.
- 2) Rosters and insurance card for each player or (Birth Certificates, Photos of players, Proof of League Registration and Proof of Insurance) are required at time of check-in.
- 3) 10 minutes before game time, the Managers or a team representatives will participate in a coin flip to determine home team and review of division rules.
- 4) Home Team is responsible for keeping the Official score book (provided by YCASA), completing the official scorecard and providing the Umpire with the information upon completion of game.
- 5) No roster add-ons or changes of any kind can be made after rosters are checked in.
- 6) No Travel Ball Teams / Players or C.I.F. Players will be allowed.
- 7) Player eligibility: Player age as of December 31st, 2013.
- 8) Game Duration:
- (1) Pool play: 1 hour 20 minutes drop dead. Umpire is the official timekeeper.
- (2) Elimination bracket play: No new inning after 1 hour 20 minutes or 6 innings (8U), 7 innings for 10U, 12U and 14U Divisions.

Pool Play: \*\*Modified drop dead after 1 hour and 20 minutes or seven innings in the 10, 12, 14 and 6 innings in the 8 and under division.

Elimination games: no new inning after 1 hour and 20 minutes in all divisions.

\*\*Modified drop dead: If the home team is ahead at the end of drop dead time, the game is over whether or not the inning is completed. If the visiting team is at bat at the time of expiration, you revert back to the last completed inning.

- a) If the visiting team is up at the time game is called, the score shall revert back to the last completed inning.
- b) If the home team is up at the time game is called and they are losing the game, the score shall revert to the last completed inning.
- c) If the home team is up to bat at the time game is called and the home team has tied up the game in that half inning, the score shall stand and will not revert back.
- d) If the home team is up to bat at the time game is called and the visiting team has tied up the game in the previous half inning, the score will revert back to the last completed inning.
- f) If the home team is up to bat and is leading, the score shall stand and will not revert back.
- g) If any championship game is tied after regulation innings or time limit, the game will move to the International Tie Breaker (Runner @ 2nd Base)
- h) Round Robin batting is mandatory in all divisions during pool play and Championship play.
- i) Dugout Conduct will be strictly enforced per ASA rules.
- j) Courtesy runner (the last out) for the pitcher or catcher is allowed.
- k) If any Coach, Player or other person associated with the team is ejected from a game, they shall remain ejected for the remainder of the current game AND ALSO THE NEXT SCHEDULED TEAM GAME. A second ejection of ANY person associated with that team, regardless of offender or offense, will result in team removal from the remainder of the tournament.
- l) Any rule protests must be declared prior to the next pitch and will be considered by the plate umpire and UIC on duty. The game and game time will be stopped. The manager must be prepared to cite the rule he/she feels is being violated.
- m) \$100.00 in cash will accompany any protest and will only be returned if the protest is won. The ruling will immediately be made on the field by the UIC. All UIC decisions are final with no other appeal process available.

- n) Three (3) games guaranteed for each team with more than 3 teams in the division. If only 3 teams in the division four (4) games will be guaranteed. Two pool play and double elimination bracket play.
- o) Mercy Rule: 15 runs after 3 complete innings; 10 runs after 4 complete innings or 8 runs after 5 complete innings.
- p) One (1) Offense trip onto the field per inning; Three (3) Defense trips per 7 innings; The 4th trip will result in a pitching change per ASA Rule
- q) Tournament pool/seed record tie-breaker will be in the following order:
- 1. # of wins
- 2. Least runs allowed
- 3. Run Differential
- 4. Runs Scored
- 5. Coin Flip
- r) A tie in pool play will stand as a tie and teams will be credited with ½ a point. A tie in elimination bracket play after the appropriate time limit or Seven (7) innings will move to the International Tie Breaker. Six (6) innings for 8U
- s) Game Time is forfeit time unless a team is involved in back to back games.
- t) Double base rule is in effect.
- u) 8U will be played according to modified league and ASA rules (see below).
- v) 10U, 12U & 14U will be played following standard ASA rules.

All ASA Junior Olympic 8U rules will be followed except for the following:

- No Coach pitch, only player pitch
- Pitching distance is 30 feet. Bases will be 45 feet.
- Round Robin batting in all games, including elimination games. (8U only)
- Free substitutions.

- Maximum of ten (10) defensive players on the field. No rover, tenth player must play outfield position.
- Unlimited pitching.
- Dead Ball Territory: Home plate is <u>OPEN</u>. A runner may steal home.
- No drop third strike.
- No infield fly in effect.
- Mercy rule per ASA (see Page 2 of our tournament rules).
