2015 Hoop It Up Rules

1. <u>High School Rules</u>

• IHSAA and IGHSAU will be used except as noted below.



2. <u>Basketball</u>

- The 28.5" basketball will be used for grades 4-8 games. Please bring warm-up balls.
- o 9th grade boys will use a men's ball. Please bring warm-up balls.
- Game balls will be provided

3. <u>Game Time</u>

- All games will be divided into two 18 minute halves.
- All games will be played with a continuous clock and will have a 3 minute halftime.
- Clock will stop for each dead ball situation the last 2 minutes of the 2nd half, only if the point differential between the two teams is 20 points or less.
- o Boys' & girls' games will start with a jump ball, with alternate possessions following.
- A team that is not ready to play 5 minutes after the scheduled time will forfeit. Teams should be ready to play 15 minutes ahead of schedule.

4. <u>Overtime</u>

- The 1^{st} overtime will be regulation clock 2 minutes.
- The 2^{nd} overtime will be regulation clock 1 minute.
- Sudden death after 2 overtimes.
- \circ 1 30 second time-out per overtime.

5. <u>Time-outs</u>

• Each team will be allowed 3 one minute time-outs per game.

6. <u>3-Point Field Goals</u>

• When available, 3-point field goals will be allowed in all grade divisions for both boys & girls.

7. <u>Full Court Pressing and Zone Defense</u>

- Zone defense will be allowed.
- No full court press after a 20 point lead.
- 4th and 5th grade man to man defense ONLY press (man to man ONLY) allowed in last minute of both halves

8. <u>Uniforms</u>

- Reversible shirts are encouraged.
- o All uniforms should have legal numbers: 1-5, 10-15, 20-25, 30-35, 40-45, and 50-55.

9. <u>Officials</u>

• All scheduled games will have at least one certified official; 2014 Tournament had two certified officials at each game.

10. <u>Coaches</u>

• Only team players and a maximum of 2 coaches will be allowed to sit on the bench during games.

11. <u>Scorekeeper/clock</u>

• Each team must provide ADULT scorekeeper/clock operator.

<u>SPORTSMANSHIP</u> – Any player, coach, parent, or spectator that does not exemplify good sportsmanship will be asked to leave the building.
