

LOCKPORT BOYS BASEBALL LOCKPORT LOCKDOWN TOURNAMENT HR DERBY

GENERAL RULES/REQUIREMENTS/NOTES

- Each team will be allowed 2 participants maximum to compete in the HR Derby
- HR Derby will consist of two rounds: Qualifying round and Championship round
- Winner will be crowned based on total cumulative home runs from both the Qualifying round and Championship round.
- During the Qualifying round, each kid will be allowed to hit as many home runs until he reaches 7 outs. Any pitch that is swung at and does not result in a home run will be an out.
- After all kids get a turn in the Qualifying round, the top three will move on to the Championship round
- If there is a tie after the Qualifying round, there will be a 3 out tie-breaker. This will continue until a tie-breaking winner is determined and the top three will move on. Home runs hit during the tie-breaker do not count towards your overall score.
- Similar to the Qualifying round, each kid will get 7 outs in the Championship round. Same tiebreaker rules apply from the Qualifying round until a winner is crowned.
- Each kid will be responsible for bringing his own pitcher; however it must be an adult (i.e. Coach or Dad).
- Teammates that are present and not participating in the HR Derby will be allowed on the field to shag all balls that are not home runs. The kids must not interfere with a ball that has home run potential.
- Lockport American Legion will conduct National Anthem Opening Ceremonies to kick-off the event and tournament promptly at 5:30 PM
- Concession Stand will be open
