

PLAYOFF INFORMATION

HOW MANY TEAMS ADVANCE?

The number of teams that will qualify for playoffs is based on how many teams are in the division.

- 1-5 teams in division – top 2 teams advance
- 6-8 teams in division – top 4 teams advance
- 9-12 teams in division - top 6 teams advance (top 3 in each pool if division has pools)
- 13+ teams in division - top 8 teams advance if 2 pools (top 4 teams from each pool advance), top 12 teams advance if 3 pools (top 4 teams from each pool advance).

HOW ARE TIE BREAKERS DETERMINED?

Tie Breakers –

- 1) Winners of each division will be determined by win/loss record.
- 2) Two way ties are determined by head to head Competition. A tie is defined as the same win/loss record). Three or more team ties are determined by head to head **IF** each team in the tie has played each other. If all teams have not played each other then rule 3 applies.
- 3) If more than two (2) teams tie, a point differential tie-breaker will be applied (+13/-13: the maximum that you can beat a team by and still gain an advantage is 13 points.). The team with the **fewest points** will be tossed out.. The two remaining teams will then go back to the head to head tie-breaker. If no head to head is applicable then the point differential tie-breaker will be applied. If two (2) teams are still tied after the application of the point differential formula then the fewest defensive points allowed will break the tie. If there is still a tie then a coin toss will be implemented.
The score of all forfeits shall be 13-0.
