PGF FUTURES RULES (Updated 10/6/2016)

- . Seeding will be based off first two in pool pool games played only!! Other pool games will be used as opportunity to move kids around and work on things if needed.
 - NFHS Rules will govern the tournament unless specified otherwise.
 - In order to stay as close as possible to the schedule, all teams must be ready to play 15 minutes prior to their scheduled start time. If coach is not at coin flip other team will get choice to home or away.
 - 3. Coin Toss determines home team for pool play. Higher seed will have choice for elimination play. Coin flip for the Championship game.
 - 4. Pool games will be 70-minute finish the inning. No new inning will start after 65 min., except the Championship Game which will be 7 innings.
 - 5. Run rule; 10 after 3, 8 after 4, and 6 after 5.
 - 6. Courtesy runner for pitcher and catcher shall be the last batted out or substitute not in game.
 - 7. Pitchers must have both feet in contact with the rubber before forward stride
 - 8. You may bat up to 12 players., with unlimited substitution or you may only bat 9 and use DP/Flex
 - 9. The home team will be the official scorekeeper.
 - 10. Both teams are responsible to turn in game results to the

concession stand area or designated person at your field within fifteen minutes of game ending. Or you will forfeit game, and it will result in a 7-0 loss

- 11. Pool games can end in tie.
- 12. In elimination play if a tie exists at the end of 7 innings or when the time limit is reached, the tie-breaker will be used. We will put runner on 2nd and 3rd at the top of the next inning.
- 13. Final pool rankings will be based on team's won/loss record. If a tie exists, the tie breaker will be: A) Head to head B) Runs allowed C) Runs scored D) Coin toss.
- 14. In the event we are unable to complete the tournament, teams will be ranked advanced through brackets based on won/loss record, head to head matchups will be tie breaker. If no head to head, we will go to runs allowed if still tied runs scored.
- 15. When the umpire takes the field, this constitutes a game.
- 16. If a coach is ejected from a game he will sit the remainder of that game, and the entire next game his team plays.
- 17. Tournament Director reserves the right to modify the tournament if necessary due to weather, or unforeseen circumstances. No Protests.
