2016 Houston National Summer Showcase

Welcome to the 2016 Houston National Summer Showcase basketball tournament hosted by Brian Jolivette/Houston Hoops. The Houston National Summer Showcase is the final of four(4) events we host annually.

The Houston National Summer Showcase is intended to provide great competition at all levels and serves as a vehicle for players to exhibit their talent before college coaches. We hope you enjoy the event, travel safely and please conduct yourselves properly at all times and inform your kids that their every move will be monitored by college coaches.

We work extremely hard to host a 1st class event but the success of the event depends on the cooperation and commitment from the coaches and players. Please be aware of the following rules and key notes:

- Spectator entry fee is \$10/day. No weekend passes.
- Games are scheduled to last 1 hour and 5 minutes. Please arrive minimum of 30 minutes prior to game time and visit the check in table.
- At the time of check in you will receive a roster sheet to complete with players first & last name and number. Please keep your roster list for the entire weekend and provide your roster list to the scorekeeper prior to each game the entire weekend (MAKE SURE THE SCOREKEEPER RETURN YOUR ROSTER LIST)
- As teams enter the facility you will be directed to the team registration room to validate your NCAA coaching credentials and player information provided to the NCAA. We will provide tournament bands to (2) certified coaches. If a coach is not certified with the NCAA the coach is not permitted to sit on the bench and the coach must pay the spectator entry fee.
- Each coach will receive a band to be worn the entire weekend and the coach must check in each day.
- Coaches and fans are expected to conduct themselves with respect. VULGARITY and AGGRESSIVE behavior directed at the referees is not permitted. Failure to comply will result in dismissal from the event for the entire weekend.
- Each team will play three(3) pool games and advance to single elimination bracket play.
- Maximum points differential: + or 15
- Some pools consist of four(4) or more teams and each team will play two(3) games resulting in some teams not playing each other. Should teams complete pool play with the same record the following rules will be used to determine tie breakers:
 - Head to head
 - Points differential
 - Points scored
 - Points allowed
- If a team suspects that a player is not eligible via grade and/or age the team reporting the potential infraction must pay a non-refundable fee in the amount of \$100 to the gym manager. The grievance must be filed prior to the start of the game. The coach of the team with the potential ineligible player must provide report card and birth certificate immediately. Failure to provide will result in player dismissal from the tournament.
