WEST SENECA GIRLS SOFTBALL 2017 TOURNAMENT RULES

The format shall be round robin into the pool elimination round. There is a four (4) game guarantee. In case of inclement weather, the tournament director reserves the right to change tournament format as well as guaranteed number of games.

- 1. Ages: 10, 12, 14, 16 and 18 under as of January 1st, 2017. Open group has no age restrictions.
- 2. NSA official rules will apply except where noted otherwise. Protests are to be resolved at the time of the protest. Chief Umpire will make final decision on protests.
- 3. Rosters & Insurance Certificates are to be submitted at least ½ hour prior to a team's first game. Birth dates, players' names and uniform number are to be included on each roster; birth certificates must be available upon request. Each team must supply a phone number where the head coach or his representative may be contacted in case of last minute schedule changes.
- 4. Teams should be ready to play 15 minutes prior to scheduled game time.
- 5. Home team will be determined by coin flip. The home team will be the official scorer. In elimination rounds, the higher seed will have a choice of being home or away team.
- 6. Final scores are to be reported by both teams to the scorer's table after each game
- 7. Diamonds are not to be used for infield or batting practice before games. No hitting (soft toss) into fences
- 8. Games are scheduled for 7 inning except:
 - a. No new inning to start after 1:30 minutes of play.
 - b. Ties will count for round robin play, Mercy rule in accordance to NSA rules:
 - i. 12 runs after 3 innings
 - ii. 10 runs after 4 innings
 - iii. 8 runs after 5 innings
 - c. For elimination games no new inning after 1:30, after time limit or 7 inning, international tie breaker will go in effect.
 - d. We will use a point system to determine seedings for elimination, wins = 2 points, ties = 1 point, loss = 0 points
- 9. Round Robin standings will be determined by:
 - a. Highest Point Total
 - b. Least amount of runs allowed
 - c. Head to head, if all teams tied played against each other
 - d. Coin flip/ draw straws
- 10. All teams advance to the playoff round in accordance to assigned schedules. All 4th Games will be played on Sunday, number of teams will determine elimination schedule.

- 11. Semi Final and Championship games will have **2 hour time limits**; after time limit or 7 innings, international tie breaker will go in effect. Mercy rules will remain in effect.
- 12. Each team is responsible for their own insurance; neither WSGSA nor the Town of West Seneca assumes any responsibility for accidents or injuries.
- 13. Any team having to forfeit in the round robin play, will be charged with a 7-0 loss.
- 14. In the event an uneven number of teams are registered for the tournament, in order to schedule evenly, a host (West Seneca Magic) team will only be scheduled 2 round robin play games and will be credited with a tie for their 3rd game, the runs for and against for the tie will be an average for the two games they played.
- 15. Players are limited to playing for only one team in any age group throughout the tournament.
- 16. Game balls will be provided; they are to be returned to the concession stands after the completion of each game.
- 17. Rosters are limited to fifteen (15) players. (Except the Open age group where there is no limit to roster, however a player may not be added after the first pitch of the first game)
- 18. Steel/Metal spikes allowed in ages 14U, 16U, 18U and Open age groups
- 19. WSGSA tournament directors reserve the right to change rules as required.
- 20. In the event of shortening of the Tournament due to unforeseen circumstances: The final standings will be awarded as follows: the highest remaining seed will be declared Champions, the second highest remaining seed will be declared runner-up. Under no circumstances will the tournament be extended past Sunday.
- 21. For 10U Silver Division we will use Metro 10U B division rules. No dropped third strike, no infield fly and no stealing home.
- 22. Game scores and final seeding will be posted on tourneymachine.com per the link sent to all head coaches.
- 23. Coaches/ Managers will be responsible to check at tournament link for their seedings / game times for elimination rounds.
