Tournament Rules

Rosters must be submitted before Friday February 24th. Only coaches and team members listed on entry roster will be allowed to sit on bench. A copy of birth certificate or report card must be provided to Tournament Director or site coordinators on demand. This is NOT an AAU sanctioned event.

Home team is the **first one listed on the schedule or the top one**. Home team shall wear light colored jerseys; visitors shall wear dark colored jerseys. **Home team will provide official scorer. Visiting team will run clock.**

Mercy Rule: A team trailing by more than **20 points** will have a continuous running clock until the lead is brought below 17. Unless otherwise specified herein, rules shall be the same as NHSF rules.

Protests: All Protests are \$50. If the protest is won then you will receive the \$50 back. All teams should have proper documents for all players (either report card or Birth Certificate). If a team is not able to provide that at protest the team will be disqualified from the tournament.

Games will consist of:

12 minute halves for 4th- 5th Grade divisions

14 minute halves for 6th- 9th Grade divisions

3 minute Half -time

Start time = 3 minutes after previous game. Teams not present at start time will forfeit.

Over time: 2 minutes for first OT; 1 minute thereafter. Each team gets 1 timeout per OT.

1 and 1 on the 10th team foul (NO DOUBLE BONUS)

Basketball Sizes- 4th -6th (28.5 Balls), 7th - 11th (Regulation Basketball)- Home team provides ball

Time Outs: Each team shall have 4 timeouts per game, 2- full, 2-30 second.

Free Throws- Move on the release

Home Team: First team listed or top team will be the Home team and wear light color uniforms, and will be the official scorer at the scorers table. Second team or bottom team will be Visitor and responsible for the Clock at the scorers table.

Conduct: Referees, at their discretion, may call a technical foul on the bench for unruly or unsportsmanlike conduct of fans. Coaches and players receiving two technical fouls will be suspended for the remainder of the current game and all of the next game. The HEAD coach is responsible for the action of his team.

Pool play – Each team will play the other two/three in their pool, before advancing to championship round.

Qualified Bracket Play— each team plays two games to determine seeding in a single elimination bracket. Order of finish for seeding and Pool play will be determined as follows:

- Won-loss record
- Head to head results
- Points Allowed
- Points Scored
- Margin of victory/loss: + 15/-15 point maximum allowed per game

Directions to Blayton & Hornsby School:

From Interstate 64: Take exit 234A to merge onto VA-199 E go 2 miles and take the US-60 exit toward Lightfoot/Williamsburg, turn left onto US-60 W/Richmond Rd, take your first left onto Virginia 614 W (Centerville Road), go about 1.7 miles and turn right onto Jolly Pond Rd/State Route 611, go about 1.5 miles and both schools will be on your left.

Directions to Jamestown High School:

From Norfolk: Take Interstate 64 West to Williamsburg. Take Exit 242-A toward Williamsburg/Jamestown and travel west on Route 199 for 6 miles. Turn left at the stoplight onto Route 5 West (John Tyler Hwy) and follow it for 3.2 miles. Turn left at the stoplight (Intersection at Eagle Way). Jamestown High School will be on the right. You will drive past the school to the second driveway.

From Richmond: Take Interstate 64 East for 36.4 miles to Williamsburg, Take Exit 234-A (Lightfoot Exit) and turn right. You are now on 199 traveling east for 6.3 miles. Take the Monticello Rd exit, turn right. Go through two stoplights, turn left onto Greensprings Plantation Rd. Go through the next light and Jamestown High School will be on the right. You will drive past the school to the second driveway.
