Rules and Information

- Admission is \$8.00 per day. Weekend passes will be available on Saturday for \$14.00. (Children under 12 are free)
- · Concession stands will be available at each site.
- Championship Medals will be awarded to all Champions in each age bracket.

The Athletic Headquarters will supply game specific score sheets to each scorer's table. These are the official score sheets for each game.

Home team is listed first on the schedule and visiting team is listed second.

*** Home team will keep the official score sheet. Score sheets are in the labeled binder on the scorer's table and are team specific for each game. ALL score sheets must remain in the binder at the end of each game. Failure to complete the official score sheets can result in forfeit for the home team.

*** Visiting team will run the game/score clock at ALL sites. Failure to provide a clock keeper could result in forfeit.

All grades 9-12 boys and girls will play two 16 minute, stop time halves. All grades 4-8 boys and girls will play two 14 minute, stop time halves.

EXCEPTION! If at any point in the game a team takes a lead of 20 points or more, the clock will run. If the lead goes back below 20 points, the clock will once again stop. Pre-game warm up will be 3 minutes. If a team is not prepared to play after the warm up period, 5 more minutes will be put on the clock. IF the team is still not ready to play the game may be forfeited. Games may start early. Please be prepared.

Halftime will be 2 minutes.

Overtime Period - First will be 2 minutes in duration, with 1 extra time out. Second overtime is sudden death.

Pressing is allowed at all levels:

No press at any level if your team has a lead of 20 or more points.

- Each team will be allowed (3) 30 second time outs per game.
- 1 & 1 will be awarded on the 10th foul per half **AND** in the last minute of every game
- Players will be allowed 6 personal fouls.
- 3 point goals allowed at all levels (If the court has 3 point lines.)
- Any player or coach receiving two technical fouls in one game is excused from that game. Tournament ejections are at the discretion of The Athletic Headquarters Staff.
- Grade 4-6 boys and girl's division MUST play with a women ball (28.5)
- On Foul Shots Rebounders can go on foul shooters release.
- Any age challenge, or any other protest, by an opposing coach will require a \$25.00 cash fee.
- All teams should have a book with proof of age for each player, in case your team gets challenged. Tournament director will rule on all challenges.

Tie-Breaker System/Playoffs:

If ties occur, we will use the following factors in order to determine championship participants.

- 1. Head to Head
- 2. Score Differential 20 points maximum per game
- 3. Fewest points allowed
- 4. Total points scored

All other rules follow NYS High School Guidelines.
