After a couple years of coaching, Wayne became a member of the DYA board and eventually became the commissioner of travel baseball in Dublin. Wayne was an active participant in the entire travel baseball program and wanted to make Dublin travel baseball the best program in central Ohio. Wayne lost his battle to cancer in 2002 at the age of 46, although the legacy he made on the travel baseball program continues to live on.
