4. Conduct: The Head coach listed on the team entry is responsible for his/her actions, the behavior of the team, its players, and its fans. The Tournament Director, Site Director, or Referees can eject any coach, player, team, or fan whose actions violate with the expected conduct of the tournament. **Fans and coaches are expected to be positive and supportive and understand that all adults are to set the proper example for our kids.**
5. Tournament Format: Round Robin (Minimum 2-games), + tournament bracket with championship game (Awards for all Tournament winners)
6. Game Rules: **VHSL Rules (all games officiated by VHSL certified officials)**
  - *Warmup*: 4 minute warm-up (minimum of 2 minutes if games are behind)
  - *Game Time*: Two 14- minute halves stop clock (Grades 4th -6th); Two 16 - minute halves stop clock (Grades 7th -10th)
  - *Fouls*: The bonus will occur on 10th team foul; The double bonus will occur on the 12th team foul
  - *Halftime*: 3 minute halftime
  - *Timeouts*: two full and two 30 second time outs per game
  - *Overtime*: Overtime will be 2 minutes in length with 1 additional time out. Second overtime will follow the same rules. Third overtime will be 1 minute in length. Any overtime after the third overtime period will result in sudden death overtime.
  - *Slaughter Rule*: Running clock with a 25 point lead at any time in the game (once 25 point lead is attained, clock will not stop unless margin reaches 15 or less points). No full-court press with minimum 25-point lead.
  - Two technical fouls for any player or coach throughout the tournament will result in ejection from all tournament games.
7. Team Rosters: Coaches must bring **Team Rosters** with them **AT CHECK-IN, 30 minutes prior to the start of their first game (in addition to entering one in through online team registration or paper registration)**. All players participating in the games should be listed on the team rosters with correct information. Team Rosters will be limited to fifteen (15) players and three (3) coaches. Teams may not add players after they check-in at the tournament. Only those persons listed on the Team Rosters may sit on the bench.

8. Home/Away Team: The first team or top team listed on the game schedule is the HOME team and shall wear light colored jerseys. The second or the bottom team listed on the game schedule is the AWAY team.

**The HOME team will provide the official scorebook keeper & book.**

**The VISITING team is responsible for supplying someone to run the CLOCK.**

9. Game Balls: **Home team provides game ball.**

4th - 6th grade boys: 28.5" intermediate size basketball

7th - 10th grade boys: 29.5" official men's size basketball

10. Seating: Bleachers are present on some courts for some games. All spectators should be in the bleacher area or seating area where bleachers are placed. Players and coaches only in designated areas near the "bench" (no parents).

11. Injuries: The Head Coach is responsible for the medical emergency of his or her players in the event of an accident, injury, or illness.

12. Protest: No protests are allowed.

13. Admission Fee:

ONE-DAY PASS...Admission is \$7 (adult) and \$3 (8-and-under) for children and children 2 and under are FREE.

TWO-DAY PASS...Admission is \$10 (adult) and \$5 (8-and-under) for children and children 2 and under are FREE

14. Concessions:

Will be sold on-site.

15: Facility Rules:

- Only **Water** or **sports drinks** are allowed on the bench by players and coaches.
- No other outside food or drink will be allowed.
- Please clean the player bench area after your game (remove all bottles, etc.)
- Foul language will not be tolerated. Coaches, fans and players must conduct themselves in a respectful way.
- Pay attention to restricted areas and please observe all rules.
- Offenses will be reported to the head coach.
- Please do not leave trash in the parking lots.
