LATE REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Late registration for those players that did not attend the Friday night event at R Place, will be offered at the Competition Venues. AM Pool Wave - 7am to 7:30am, PM Pool Wave – 11:00 – 12:30pm.

It is possible that due to last minute cancellations, changes in the Pool Play schedule may occur. Current NAGVA rules will be followed, and are detailed below in the Rules Section.

POOL PLAY FORMAT

All Cat Fight teams will play 4 Pool matches of 2 games each, for a total of 8 games. Pool games will be played to 25 points starting at 4-4, with a 27 point cap, win by 2. If the teams are tied when the round ends, one additional point will be played to determine the set winner.

OPEN – AA/A DIVISION POOL DETAILS

The Open AA/A Division consists of one 8 – team & one 7 – team pool, both played in the AM Wave. AA/A – Pool 1 will be played on Courts – UW1 & UW3, and AA/A – Pool 2 will be played on Courts – UW4 & UW6.

DOUBLE ELIMINATION BRACKET PAIRINGS

The Double Elimination seeds and Match Pairings will be based on Saturday's Pool Play results. Teams will be ranked top to bottom based on Games Won and Lost, if a tie - breaker is needed, the tie - breaker will be Point Win %. (Points Won / Total Points Played). Standard NAGVA approved double elimination brackets will be used. It is expected that all Team Captains will verify their team's results before leaving the gyms on Saturday afternoon. The Open AA/A brackets will be decided using NAGVA rules.

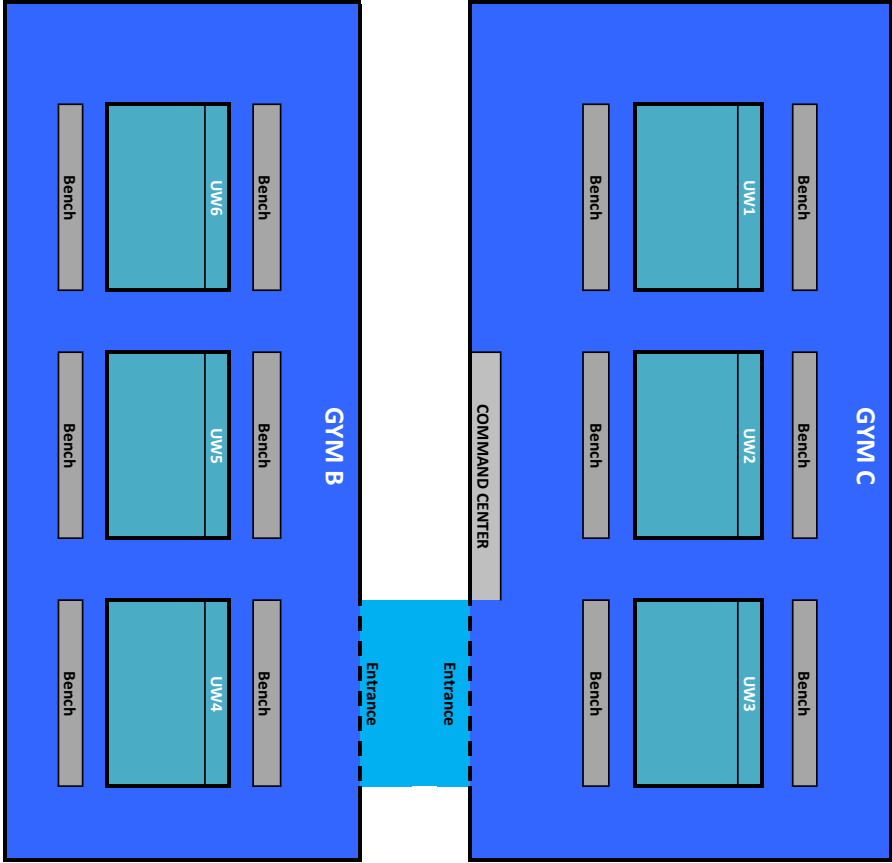

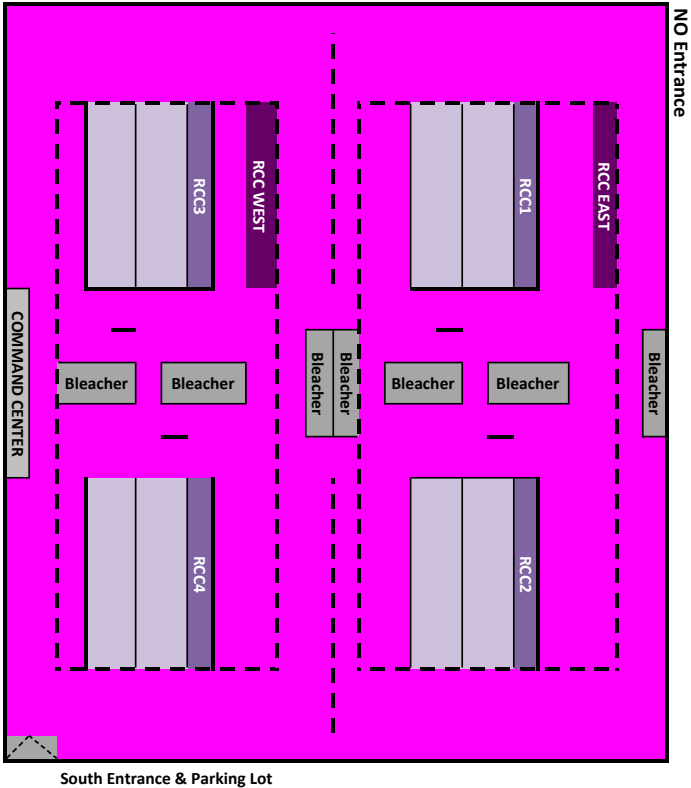

7:30 – 10pm - Come to R Place for Free Drafts & Double Well Cocktails. Enjoy great music & socialize with your fellow Cat Fighters on the 1st & 2nd Floors and the 3rd Floor beginning at 9pm. When you arrive, present your SVC "V" Card to the Cat Fight Rep and you will receive 2 Free Drink tickets redeemable for double well drinks and draft beer. So come hang out, drink and eat, Final Pool Play Results, Seeds and Double Elimination Match Pairings will be posted on the Cat Fight website by 10pm.

DOUBLE ELIMINATION BRACKET PLAY

Sunday tournament play will begin promptly at 7:45am at the UW IMA & Rainier Community Centers for the BB & B divisions. Open AA & A bracket play times will be announced on Saturday evening.

WINNER'S BRACKET

Winners' bracket matches are best of 3 games, win by 2 points with no cap. The first 2 games are played to 25 points starting at 4-4, and if a 3rd game is needed it will be played to 15, no caps on any games. If after the Championship match, both teams have lost one match, one 25-point game without a cap will be played to determine the Divisional Tournament Champion.

CHALLENGER'S BRACKET

All Challenger's bracket matches are a single 25-point games starting at 0; win by 2 points without a cap.

Site Directors reserve the right to reformat matches in order to keep the tournament on schedule.

AWARDS CEREMONY

Immediately following the last Divisional Championship match, we will hold the Cat Fight Award Ceremony at the UW IMA. Medals and Team Trophies will be presented to the top 3 finishing teams in each division. 7 member All Tournament Teams will be selected for each division, 5 All-Stars, a Defensive Diva and MVP. All individuals named to the All Tournament Teams, will receive a personal award and Cat Fight apparel item.

CAT FIGHT RULES OF PLAY

FACILITIES & EQUIPMENT

1. Coolers are not allowed inside the gyms. Only water in a sealed container is allowed on the hardwood playing surface. All other food and beverages must be consumed and stored in the non-playing areas.
2. Alcohol, pornographic material, and other similar items are prohibited on any facility premise:
 - a. **PENALTY IS IMMEDIATE EXPULSION FROM CAT FIGHT!**
3. BBQ'S and grills are not allowed on any ECCF Facility premises, including parking lots.
4. The Official Ball of ECCF 2017 is the Molten VM5000 Flistatec.
5. All uniforms must have visible numbers on the front and back; the Libero must wear a contrasting jersey.

ADMINISTRATION

6. All NAGVA Rules are in effect - including recently adopted USAV rules regarding centerline, net contact, double contacts (i.e. allowed for spectacular/athletic effort when setting the ball), Libero Serve & 2 Liberos. If you are not familiar with these rules, please refer to the NAGVA presentations for officiating at <http://nagva.org/docs.cfm>.
7. Pool Play Matches are scheduled at 40 minutes inclusive of a 5-minute warm-up period.
8. Pool Play Rounds will be timed by a central clock, and all matches will begin and end together.
9. Pool Play Format will be 2 games to 25 starting at 4-4, 27 Cap. If tied when time expires play one additional point.
10. Timeouts – 30 seconds, 2 per game provided there is more than 3 minutes remaining in that round.
11. Substitutions are permissible within 3 minutes of a round's completion.
12. Forfeits will be strictly enforced according to NAGVA / USA Volleyball rules (e.g., if a playing team is not ready when a match is scheduled to begin). If the assigned working team is not present and ready to start a match, they will forfeit the first game of their next match, inclusive of Double Elimination rounds.
 - a. Procedure – 2 timeouts, Forfeit 1st Game. 3 mins between games + 2 timeouts, forfeit match, 5mins!
13. 6 Player Minimum - Teams must have six (6) players on the court in order to compete. If a team becomes incomplete through disqualification or expulsion of a player the Team loses that game by default, keeping the points earned. If a team becomes incomplete due to injury or illness that team may acquire a replacement player (who has met NAGVA eligibility requirements) at, or below the division in which the team is playing in. The replacement player shall be taken from an available player from the host city with the approval of the host city's tournament director or, if none available, from a team that has already been eliminated from the tournament
14. No Certified Referees - Teams will be charged the following fees if they do not have certified officials: subject to avail.
 - a. \$30 for a certified up-referee (per match); and,
 - b. \$30 for a certified scorekeeper (per match).

DURING COMPETITION

15. **Service Area** (When gym setup 2 courts per side) – **Rainier CC** – Servers are allowed 1 **reasonable** step into court, and 2 **reasonable** for jump serves. (Reasonable = 12 inches, these facilities have less than 6 feet of service space)
16. **Basketball Hoops** – Are considered part of the wall when swung away, unless the ball strikes the rim over a playable area, and are at the Referee's discretion if there could have been a play made on the ball, a replay may be called.
17. **Adjacent Courts** – Play is automatically over when a player enters another court while in pursuit of the ball.
18. **The ball** is out of play if it hits the ceiling or any other equipment, device, etc. on the opposite site of the court.
19. **Divider Curtain** – Balls are dead if they hit, only players contacting the ball can move a divider curtain to play.
20. **Protests** – A Referee's judgment call always stands. If you do not agree with a Referee's application or interpretation of a rule, you may file a protest, but must be filed before the next service. The protest must be noted on the score sheet by the scorekeeper, and the game will halt until the Protest Committee can make a ruling. Once a ruling has been made, the game will proceed where it left off.
21. **Protest Committee** – Will consist of the Tournament or Site Director, NAGVA Regional Commissioner or Rep and a non-partisan Cat Fight Team Captain at or above the current level of play for that match.
