

Pitching Rules for World Series

THIS is considered a 4 DAY TOURNAMENT

6.12 Pitching limitations are described in 6.12.1. When a pitcher is removed he may not return to the mound. Once a pitcher becomes the pitcher of record and throws a warm up pitch, it will be counted as one inning. If a pitcher is in violation of a pitching rule, the opposing team must officially protest the game while he/she is the pitcher of record.

6.12.1 Pitching Rules

- * 3 Innings is the most you can pitch in a day and legally pitch the next.
- * 7 Innings is the most you can pitch in any single day.
- * 14 innings is the most you can pitch over 4 days.

Single day event-7 innings max

- * A pitcher may pitch in 3 consecutive days but not 4.

NOTE: (9U-13U) As long as the pitcher does not exceed 3 innings in a day, they may pitch the next day. However, the maximum innings in a day or across multiple days will be enforced.
