



# 2017 Girls Hershey Lacrosse Shootout Tournament Rules

### **RULES OF PLAY:**

- 3rd grade 4<sup>th</sup> Grade is 10v10 including goalie
- 5th grade 6<sup>th</sup> Grade 12v12 including goalie, modified stick checking is allowed
- 6<sup>th</sup> grader Teams and under must play U.S. Lacrosse Youth Level A rules
  - Modified checking
  - o 3 Second Rule for good defensive positioning
  - o The 4-goal rule will NOT be used
  - o The 1 pass rule will NOT be used
  - o Red Card(Flagrant) the player will be required to sit out their next game
- 7<sup>th</sup> graders Teams may elect to play regular U.S. Lacrosse Women's Rules
  - Full Checking
  - o Red Card(Flagrant) the player will be required to sit out their next game
- 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Varsity is 12 v12 unless agreed to otherwise before start

## **DURATION OF PLAY:**

- Regulation Size Fields
- Games consist of ONE 40-minute game
- NO time outs
- Free position is taken after the horn sounds
- During an injury time out, clock will run
- Score to be kept by the officials on the field. Official's rulings are final
- No jewelry, no band aids covering the jewelry
- Goalies must wear all equipment (shins and thigh pads, mouthguards)
- A central horn starts and stop each game
- Home team is the team listed first. Home team will wear pinnies if necessary
- If a coach is issued a yellow card it counts as a team foul and the team must remove a player from the field.
- IF YOU HAVE 5 GAMES, YOUR 5<sup>TH</sup> GAME WILL NOT COUNT TOWARDS YOUR STANDINGS
- Play off tie breakers
  - o Points, Head to head (If they play each other head to head, if not goes to goals against), Goals against, Coin toss
- If any team's ties in a Playoff Game or Champ Game there will be a 3-Man Braveheart plus goalie, First Goal Wins!

## **SPORTSMANSHIP**

• Sportsmanship is important. Please respect the coaches, referees, players & fans.

### RULES RELATED TO INCLEMENT WEATHER:

- There are no "rain dates" for the Hershey Lacrosse Shootout. Assume that games will be played on their scheduled dates.
- If inclement weather that causes a game stoppage (i.e. lightning sighting) during the event, the following rules apply:
- Play will stop until the head official deems the weather suitable for resuming
- If the delay is substantial, Tournament HQ may make a decision to shorten all remaining games until the tournament is back on time.
