## General Rules and Regulations

- All games will follow current US Lacrosse Youth Rules unless specified otherwise.
- Girls
- Grades 3-4: 8v8; 2A,3M,2D,1G on 60x30 field with $6 x 6$ goal
- Grades 5-6/7-8: 12v12 on full field
- Boys
- Grades 3-4: 7v7; 2A,2M,2D,1G on $60 \times 30$ field with $6 \times 6$ goal
- Grades 5-6/7-8; 10v10 on full field
- Regulation Play
- All games are (2) 20-minute running halves
- 5-minute halftime
- 1-30 second timeout per half per team
- Stop time last 1 minute of second half only
- Overtime: sudden victory period where the first team to score a goal will be the winner. Each team receives $1-30$ second time out
- All challenges are final at end of game
- Mercy Rule: there is no mercy rule, however, good sportsmanship is HIGHLY recommended.
- NO TAKE-OUT CHECKS or ILLEGAL BODY CONTACT PERMITTED - any check in which a player lowers his head or shoulder with the force and intent to put the other player on the ground.
- Games will start at the designated time whether your team is present or not. 10 minutes late will result in forfeit.
- Any player, coach, or spectator using derogatory language on the field or bench when addressing a player, coach or referee may receive a one minute, nonreleasable penalty for the first offense, a two minute non-releasable for the second offense and expulsion from the tournament for the third offense.
- Home (top) team has game clock, Away (bottom) team has penalty time
- All spectators are expected to show good sportsmanship and to be placed on opposite side of team
- If lightning is in area, play will be suspended by 3 long air horn blasts Tournament committee will decide if game(s) will be canceled due to weather/lightning. Standard procedure will apply before play is resumed
