



T-Town Show Down
10u/12u Tournament -Rules
- June 1st – June 3rd 2017

- 3 pool play on Friday/Saturday, single elimination Sunday

GENERAL RULES

1. The Tournament Director reserves the right to change the tournament format at anytime due to weather or any unforeseen circumstances. No rain date is planned.
2. This a Non-Sanctioned Event, but all play will be governed by ASA Fast Pitch rules with the exceptions identified in these local rules.
3. Players may only be active on one roster for weekend
4. All teams must have a signed roster and proof of insurance prior to play. All teams must check in to have these items verified at/before the team's first game
5. Please have birth certificates available in event of a protest. If a manager cannot produce a player's BC upon request, team will forfeit that game and player will remain ineligible until a BC is produced. Copies are acceptable, as long as they are legible. Any illegible copies will be considered unacceptable.
6. In case of rain, managers are responsible for reviewing to confirm game times
7. Awards will be given to 1st place and 2nd place teams in each age bracket.

8. One (1) hour, finish the inning plus one more inning
9. In case of tie in elimination games, will use International Tie Breaker Rule until a winner is decided – (the last out from previous inning will start the next inning on 2nd base)
10. Championship Game will be 7 innings, no time limit. If tied, game will be played until there is a winner.
11. **Pool Play Games CAN End in a Tie.**
12. Winning team must report score to concession stand/field director
13. Pool Game- Home team is decided by coin flip.
Elimination Games – Higher Seed is Home Team
14. Mercy rules 20 after 3, 15 after 4, 7 after 5
15. Continuous batting order, 1 EH, or straight substitution rules. Must be announced to umpire and opposing coach prior to start of game.
16. No infield warm-up after 1st inning.
17. Pitcher gets 5 pitches 1st inning. 3 pitches between innings New pitcher gets 5 pitches
18. Courtesy runner may be used for catchers with two outs - must be the player who was out last
19. Protest Fee: \$100 cash, paid at time of protest. Protest must be filed prior to next pitch. Tournament Director will be judge of final decision. If Tournament Director is unavailable, then Field Manager will make decision.
