## TSSAA Basketball Rules except as follows

#### Clock:

Pregame & Halftime Periods
Games on Schedule
(3) Five Minutes Each
Games Behind

(2) Three Minutes Each Periods (Running Clock) 4<sup>th</sup> Grade & Below 15 Min Halves 5<sup>th</sup> Grade & Above 17 Min. Halves

\*\*\*\* Last two (2) minutes of the 2<sup>nd</sup> half the clock reverts back to 'Regular Clock' format and will stop on the whistle.

Overtimes:

(2) Two Minute Overtime Periods Maximum of (1) Overtime

Period in Pool Play Games

Timeouts:

(2) Full & (2) 30 sec Timeouts a game in regulation

1. Full in Each Overtime Period

#### 20 Point Lead:

If at any time during the final two (2) minutes of the 4th period the lead is more than 20 points, the clock will continue to run with the exception of a time out being called. If the 20 point lead is reduced to less than 20 points, normal clock operation will resume.
