## Tournament Rules

- $3^{\text {rd }}-6^{\text {th }}$ Grade- 14 Min Stop Time $7^{\text {th }}+8^{\text {th }}-16$ Min Stop Time Halves
- Boys $5^{\text {th }}-8^{\text {th }}$ teams use a 29.5 ball, All Girls Teams Use a 28.5 ball
- $3^{\text {rd }}-4^{\text {th }}$ Boys use 28.5 ball. Allowed free throw violations
- Teams will be given 4 minutes to warm up
- $1^{\text {st }}$ Team on Schedule (on left or top) is Home Team
- 3 Timeouts given per game ( 30 sec )
- Halftime is 2 minutes
- OT is $1^{\text {st }}$ team to 5 pts, Double Bonus Per Foul, No Timeouts in OT
- $3^{\text {rd }}-5^{\text {th }}$ Grade-Man 2 Man Press is only allowed final 2 min of each half
- Zones are allowed except in $3^{\text {rd }}-5^{\text {th }}$ (man to man, help+recover)
- No coaches are allowed to argue questionable zone play with refs (warning then technical will be given)
- All teams must be at their scheduled court ready to play $\mathbf{1 0} \mathbf{~ m i n ~ e a r l y ~}$
- Once game ends, 4 min are put up on the clock for warm-ups. Game will start after 4 min if game is up to 10 min ahead of schedule
- If lead is $20+$ points in $2^{\text {nd }}$ half, running time last 5 min
- No press is allowed with $15+$ point lead
- Teams will shoot 1 and 1 on $10^{\text {th }}$ Foul, no 2 shots
- Tie Breaker- Head to Head, +/- Pool Play Points (Max 15/game), H2H, Points Allowed 3 Teams or More- Head to Head or record against same record teams 1st
- Games outside of pool play do not count towards pool record/advancement
- 1 Parent from either team is required to do the official book at the scorers table (clock operator is provided)
