



2018 Battle at the Bridge Lacrosse Tournament Playoff Brave Heart Rules



3 vs. 3 Format including the goalie.

This is a “sudden victory” match -- First to score wins the game.

All Brave Hearts will start with a faceoff, all penalties still remaining from the end of the second half will be released unless unreleaseable (that player cannot play in the brave heart).

No timeouts. Play until a goal is scored or egregious penalty forfeiture.

Once players are selected for the Brave Heart, enter the field and play starts, there are no substitutions for the entire Brave Heart except for injuries.

During play, one player from each team will need to be in their respective defensive half of the field to remain “onside”.

Fouls during the Brave Heart:

- Technical fouls with possession of the ball, flag down.
 - The offended team will receive the ball at midfield, the penalized team will move one player to their offensive restraining line (at the other end of the field).
 - When play resumes, the penalized player is released.
- Personal fouls, flag down.
 - The offended team will receive the ball at the top of their offensive restraining line, the offending team will move one player to their respective offensive restraining line (at the other end of the field).
 - When play resumes, the penalized player is released.
- Any personal foul that results in an unreleaseable penalty.
 - The offending player is removed from the game permanently.
 - The replacement player will serve the penalty in the same manner as a personal foul.
- During all flag down penalties, each team’s goalie will start play in their respective goal circles.
- Any team or player during the Brave Heart that receive a Misconduct or Unsportsmanlike penalty will forfeit the match.
 - Game over.
