Miscellaneous Information

TOURNEY LOCATION: All teams will play their games at MI3 Center, 1135 Ella Crossing, Houston, TX 77090. Phone number: 281-888-5024

GAME RESULTS WILL BE POSTED ON TOURNEY MACHINE! Download the app for your phone to keep up to date with the tournament. Results will also be available online at www.tournneymachine.com. Search Space City Jam 2019.

GATE FEE: The gate fee will be \$40 for a family tournament pass (5 maximum-immediate family only); \$20 for an individual adult pass; \$15 for student and senior passes. Adult admission per day is \$10 and \$10 per day for student or senior. A tournament program is included with each tournament family pass while supplies last. **Tournament programs can be purchased for \$3.**

T-SHIRTS: There will be a limited supply of shirts available for sale at the door on a first come, first-served basis. The cotton short sleeve shirts are \$17, dri-fit short sleeve are \$20 & long sleeve shirts are \$20 (Add \$1 per shirt if paying by credit card). **Pre-orders can be** picked up at MI3 Center. FOOD: Concession be sold at the MI3 center. The Space City Jam staff has no control over the concessions, and all proceeds go to the facility. NO OUTSIDE FOOD, DRINKS (EXCEPT LIQUID FOR PLAYERS) OR COOLERS ARE ALLOWED IN THE FACILITY. Coaches will have access to the SCJ Hospitality Room with their Coach's Badge.

FACILITY COURTS: The courts will open at 2 PM on Thursday, 9:00 AM on Friday, and 8 AM on Saturday (30 minutes before games begin for the day). **Do not arrive early**; MI3 will not let you enter. Absolutely no food, candy, juice, soda or other concession items will be allowed on the courts at any time. Bottle water and sports drinks are allowed on the bench, but that is all. Please make sure players pick up their belongings around the bench at the end of the game. Discard all bottles into trash cans.

Tournament Rules

Game Format:

Team Division	Game Length
18U Boys & Girls	8-minute quarters
16U (JV) & 14U Boys & Girls	7-minute quarters
12U/10U Boys & Girls	6-minute quarters

Halftime Break – 3 minutes

Timeouts – Two Full; Two 30-second

Overtime – 2 minutes & 1 additional 30-second; Additional OT are 1 minute and no more timeouts.

Fouls – 1:1 at 7 fouls, 2 shots at 10 fouls

Running clock in 4th quarter with 20 point lead; normal clock resumes once lead is 15 points;

Coaches may agree to running clock prior to 4th quarter.

Home/Visitors: Home team listed first or on top of bracket; Home wears light; Visitors wear dark.

Official Score Table

- Scorebook Home Team (adult only, <u>Use official SCJ scorebook. PLEASE DO NOT attempt to keep two books.</u> Take a picture at the end of the game for your record.)
- Clock Keeper Visiting Team (HHA reserves option to keep clock at any game)

Game Ball: Home Team (with visitor team approval). Boys use 29.5. Girls use 28.5.

<u>Scheduled Game Time</u>: To ensure games stay on time, please have your teams ready to play in advance of the scheduled game time. <u>GAMES MAY START UP TO 30 MINUTES EARLY.</u>

<u>Pre-Game Warm-Up Time</u>: 5 minutes before official game time. <u>If games are running behind, warm-up time may be shortened to a minimum of 3 minutes.</u>

<u>Pre-Game Scripture & Prayer</u>: Prior to each game, teams gather in a circle at half-court for Scripture reading & prayer by Home team coach or player. SCJ provides the Scripture for each day (no Bible needed). Scripture sheet is at score table.

End of Game: Each coach nominates 1 player from opposing team for All-Tournament Team. Mark name in official SCJ score book. Tourney machine will be updated with score at conclusion of game.

<u>Tiebreakers:</u> Within Pools - Best Record, Head to Head, Highest Pt Differentials Sum, Highest Pts Scored Sum, Lowest Pts Allowed Sum; Within Divisions (for breaking ties across a full division) - Pool Place, Best Record, Head to Head, Highest Pt Differentials Sum, Highest Pts Scored Sum, Lowest Pts Allowed Sum; Max Score Differential Per Game - 25 pts

<u>Officiating:</u> Officials will not tolerate inappropriate behavior or language. Officials have the right to remove coaches, players or parents. If anyone is ejected from a game, they are done for the remainder of the tournament. If a coach receives a technical foul, he/she must sit for the remainder of the game.
