

Rock the Cages General Information

1. Check-In – A representative from each team must check-in at the HQ prior to your first game. This is located under the pavilion. Please bring a roster with your players name, jersey number and US lacrosse number. If your club does not require a US Lacrosse membership, please bring a copy of your club's insurance certificate to submit. You may also prior to the day of the event by emailing the information to rockthecages@gmail.com.
2. Schedule – The schedule will be posted on the tourney machine site. Every team will play at least 4 games. Be aware that your 4th game may be included in the pool schedule or as part of the bracket schedule. **DO NOT LEAVE** for the day with out having someone check- out with HQ.
3. Awards – We will present awards to the 1st place winners in every division. We would also like to recognize the runner-up teams. We ask that both teams in championship games please come to HQ to be recognized and take team pictures prior to leaving.
4. Facility – There are two entrances. On Saturday use both entrances. On Sunday the 3rd & 4th grade should use the southern entrance and the 5th & 6th should use the northern entrance nearest the pavilion. The small lot near the shed will be reserved the referees.
It is VERY IMPORTANT THAT YOU DO NOT PARK ON THE GRASS.
Please police your area. Garbage bags will be available at the pavilion.
5. Turf field – Only players and coaches are permitted on the turf area. No food on the turf. No tam tents on the turf.
6. Vendors – We will have food and clothing vendors each day. If you have order t-shirts they will be available for pick-up.
7. Game play- Please remember to honor the game. Treat officials and other teams with respect. This is a competitive format, but the focus should be on the players and letting them enjoy the day. Keep in mind their ages. There will be no scholarships handed out during the tournament.
8. Team Tents – We encourage you to bring your tents and fly your colors. We ask that you leave a distance from the edges of the grass field so that others may watch and pass by. Please consult the field map for locations.
