

RULES & REGULATIONS 2018 SEASON OPENER TOURNAMENT

- 1. All teams will be guaranteed a minimum of 3 scheduled games.
- 2. All games will be officiated by certified officials.
- 3. 3 minute pre-game and 3 minute half-time with 30 second quarter time breaks.
- 4. 5 minute grace period will be given if a team does not have 5 players to start the game. After this grace period a win by default will be awarded.
- 5. Gym venues will not provide any basketballs.
- 6. Both teams will supply a game ball to the officials who will chose one of the two as the official game ball.
- 7. Player may play on only 1 team in the entire tournament. All player must be below the maximum age for the division they have entered. (U14 born in 2005, U15 born in 2004 etc...)
- 8. The roster you list you submitted online is your OFFICIAL ROSTER FOR THE WHOLE TOURNAMENT. No additions will be allowed after the start of the first game.
- 9. Violence will not be tolerated. Violence or fighting will automatically result in the player or coach being disqualified from the entire tournament. Depending on the situation, the officials along with the tournament committee will decide if the game will continue or if the game will end at the score currently posted.
- 10. Anyone who is assessed the following shall be ejected from the entire tournament:
 - a) Two direct technical fouls

- b) Unruly spectator(s) will receive a warning, followed by a bench technical, followed by ejection
- c) Verbal or physical abuse as determined by the official or tournament supervisor
- 11. The tournament site will have a facility supervisor. Please direct all questions, comments, or concerns to this individual.
- 12. Regulation FIBA rules will be followed with the following exceptions:

- 13. Tiebreaking procedure to determine placing is as follows:
 - o 1st tie breaker head to head results involving all teams tied
 - 2nd tie breaker point differential system involving only teams tied. Margin of victory for games between the tied teams is a max of 15 points per game
 - o 3rd tie breaker same point differential system involving all teams in the pool
 - o 4th tie breaker coin flips
- 14. 1st OT 2 MINS STOP TIME. 1 TIME OUT

2nd OT – 1 MIN STOP TIME. 1 TIME OUT

3rd OT – SUDDEN DEATH. FIRST TEAM TO SCORE WINS. NO TIME OUTS
