## 2019 Wildcat Pepper Tournament Modified(7/8), 5/6, 3/4 Divisions Rules

The Wildcat Pepper enforces zero tolerance in relation to behavior deemed detrimental to the safety or enjoyment of the games. Any player or spectator instigating verbal insults, abuse, fighting will be expelled from the tournament.

West Genesee School District policies prohibit any use of tobacco products including vape (electronic) cigarettes. Pets are NOT allowed on school property. Tailgating including barbeque grills are not allowed.

Sunday – Modified ( $7^{th}$  &  $8^{th}$  grade) based on grade level in June 2018 will be 2023/2024 graduates  $5^{th}$  &  $6^{th}$  grade based on grade level in June 2018 will be 2025/2026 graduates  $3^{rd}$  &  $4^{th}$  grade based on graded level in June 2018 will be 2027/2028 graduates Grade levels are based on player's grade level as of June 2019

All teams need to check in 30 minutes before first game. All eligible players must be listed on team's roster. Players may play on only one team per day.

Each teams guaranteed 4 games. Two-20 minutes running time halves. Clock does not stop. No timeouts, a common horn starts and stops play. Five minute half time. 7v7 with 5 field players in either offensive or defensive zone.

If there is an 8 meter free position awarded just before horn sounds it will be taken.

Yellow / red cards – teams plays down for the entire 2 minutes. Team plays short below the restraining line.

Same player receives a 2<sup>nd</sup> yellow card in same game; she is disqualified for the rest of that game.

If a player receives a RED card (not 2 yellow cards) she is disqualified for the rest of that game and the next one.

If a player receives a RED card (not 2 yellow cards) she is disqualified for the rest of that game and the next one. If only dressed goalie receives a yellow card a teammate may serve the penalty. If only dressed goalie receives a red card she must serve the penalty.

A random stick check maybe conducted by Official before a game. Requests for a stick check or Coaches Challenge during a game will be honored.

Championship tee shirts will be awarded to the winning teams at conclusion on Championship game. 20 players maximum

7 field players plus goalie, US Lacrosse Youth Rules. Draw at beginning of each half, draws will continue after each goal, if any team is up by 4 or more goals, the losing team (goalie) will begin with the ball after each goal until the differential is less than 4. ALL DIVISIONS PLAYING IN POOLS SO TIES ARE ALLOWED IN POOL PLAY

The Referee has complete authority in all games.

Any protest will be heard by Competition Committee. Committee's decision will be final.

In the event of inclement weather the organization reserves the right to postpone, alter schedules/format or cancel games in the best interest of safety of the participants, spectators and staff members. Every effort will be put forth to accommodate the planned full schedule within a reasonable period of time to meet the needs of the teams and officials.
