From deSanno Field follow Mason Street to Nutt Rd.

Parking at deSanno Field:

All Parking is free. Street parking is available on Mason Street and the north side of Wheatland Street. Parking is permitted in the grassy area in the left field area behind the score board. There is a paved lot adjacent to the batting cage behind the senior housing center with 21 parking spaces. **NO PARKING IS PERMITTED IN ANY SENIOR CENTER PARKING AREAS. Offenders will be towed! Parking in any grassy areas other than denoted above will be ticketed and towed.**

General Usage Rule for deSanno Field

1. The deSanno Field property is completely enclosed by a fence. The main entrance to the property is at the corner of Mason & Wheatland Streets. (See aerial map)

2. There is a batting cage in the far-left corner of the property that is permitted for use by players/team members only.
3. No player is permitted in the batting cage or on the field without an adult coach.
4. The bases are major league style. The bases are not “break-away” style bases. Therefore, we ask that you alert your players to the fact they must slide early so as to avoid possible injury.
5. Coaches and players should not routinely take positions on the infield grass for the purpose of hitting to fielders or pitching to hitters. Every effort should be made to protect the grass and the edging of the dirt surfaces.
6. There is a porta-potty bathroom on site for use.
7. There is a fully function snack bar/refreshment stand at the field and will be open for all games. Items available are as follows: breakfast sandwiches, donuts, muffins, hamburgers, cheeseburgers, hot dogs, soda, water, iced tea, Gatorade, coffee, ice cream, assorted candies, assorted chips.
8. There are several trashcan receptacles throughout the property. Please use them appropriately for all trash. Please be conscious to dump out any remaining liquid into grassy areas prior to placing them in the trash cans.
