

RHAA Home Run Derby Rules

Eligibility: 2 players per team that is registered in RHAA Summer classic are eligible to play in the Home Run Derby. The participants will be assigned to the age/division in which he/she plays.

Each participant is thrown pitches by an adult of his/her choice. The hitter will have 90 seconds from the 1st pitch to hit as many pitches as they can. The pitcher must wait until a hit ball has landed before the next pitch. Home run territory shall be anywhere over the fence between the foul poles regardless of home plate's position.

The participant with a lead after the first round shall be declared the winner. Should there be a tie after the first round, a "Swing-Off" takes place. In a Swing-Off, each tied player will get 30 seconds to get as many home runs as possible. If a tie remains after the first Swing-Off, the Swing-Off round shall be repeated until a winner can be declared.

With a portable home plate, the distance to center field fence will be adjusted by division:

Bats – Tournament bat rules.

We will be using out upper fields for all divisions. Fields to be announced.

- 10u – 2nd base
- 12u – Pitching Mound area
- 14u – Home Plate

The winner and runner up of each age division will receive a trophy.
