Games Rules

- Coin flip to determine home team in all pool games.
- Continuous batting order.
- Players are not required to slide, but must avoid contact if not sliding or else they are out.
- Courtesy runners for pitchers and catchers of FOLLOWING inning (except when in final
 inning of a game); can happen at any time but must happen once there are two outs,
 runner will be last called out. No pinch runners allowed.
- 1 mound visit per inning without removing pitcher. (injury related visits don't count)
- Bats must have a wooden barrel, that is the only restriction.
- Player-coaches and youth-coaches at first must wear a helmet.

Slaughter rule

- 12 after 3
- 10 after 4
- Applies to all games

Time limit

- No new full inning may begin after time has expired.
- 1:45 for all pool play games.
- 2:00 for all quarter-finals.
- No time limit for semi-finals and finals.
- Time does NOT stop during a rain delay unless a tournament official says otherwise.

Extra Innings

- If pool play game has reached time limit and is tied, the game is deemed a tie.
- If pool play game has not reached time limit and is tied after all innings are played, california speed-up rules will apply to each additional inning until either a team wins or time expires.
- Same rules apply to quarter-finals games as are to pool play.
- If semi-final or final is tied after all innings, california speed up rules apply until a winner is determined.
- California speed up rules: last out at 2nd, one out to start each half inning.

Tournament Structure

- Pools of 4 teams, the top 2 teams from each pool advance to 6 team bracket on Sunday.
 (top 3 teams for 8u)
- Tiebreakers are 1) head to head, 2) runs against, 3) run differential (max 10).
- 3 round robin games within pool.
- Quarter-final games for all ages (4v5, 3v6) are at 8AM Sunday.
- Semi-final games for all ages (1v4/5, 2v3/6) are at 10AM Sunday.
- Championship games are as follows:
 - o 8/9u 12:15PM Sunday @ Woodland 1
 - o 10u 2:30PM Sunday @ Woodland 1
 - o 11u 12:45PM Sunday @ Jewett 2
 - o 12u 3PM Sunday @ Jewett 2
 - o 13u 1:15PM Sunday @ Jewett 1
 - o 14u 3:30PM Sunday @ Jewett 1
- Locations for quarter-finals and semi-finals will be announced Saturday night.
