

2019 Maverik National Lacrosse Classic Game Information

Game Format

- Four 10 minute running time quarters. Games/quarters started and stopped on central horn.
- 2 minute break between quarters and a 5 minute halftime.
- Each team receives one 60 second time out per half (clock continues to run). Timouts cannot be taken in the final 5 minutes of each half.
- Results of cross-pool games (Won/Loss, Goals Allowed, and Goals Scored) will not be included in the standings.
- Pool and consolation games can end in a tie. Championship bracket games can not end in a tie.

Overtime Procedures (Championship bracket only)

3v3 (plus goalie) sudden-victory Braveheart for a period of 2 minutes to determine the winner. All field players must line-up in the midfield positions for the faceoff, and at least one player must remain in the defensive half of the field (goalie or field player) at all times. No substitutions permitted after the faceoff and no timeouts permitted. Additional periods will be played until a goal is scored, however players may be replaced at the beginning of each subsequent period.

Tiebreakers (Standings)

- 1. Most Wins
- 2. Least Losses
- 3. Head-to-Head game results (if all tied teams have played each other)
- 4. Least goals allowed
- 5. Largest goal differential (Goals Scored minus Goals Allowed)
- 6. Coin flip

In the event that two or more teams remain tied after step 3, steps 4 and 5 (and 6, if necessary) will determine the highest ranked team. Steps 3, 4, and 5 (and 6, if necessary) are then repeated to determine the next ranked team, and so on.

TIEBREAKER EXAMPLE

Team A would be placed 1st, as they have the least goals allowed among the three tied teams. As there are now only two tied teams remaining, Team C would be placed 2nd, as they beat Team B. Team B would be placed 3rd.

The event committee will determine the seedings for each bracket, with pool winners receiving the top seeds. The event committee may adjust playoff seedings to avoid a first round game between two teams from the same pool.
