WELCOME

PARKING

ATTENDANTS. They will be directing incoming traffic along with tournament staff. They are directing you based on maximizing parking for all attendees and we appreciate your cooperation in following that. There will be a marked player drop off area along the east side of the tennis courts, but please do not leave cars unattended. **Additional parking is also available across 109**th **at Jackson Middle School**. There is no parking permitted on the grass or posted areas. You will be asked to move your vehicle.

We will have designated parking spots for referees. This will allow them to quickly get out to the fields and help keep our game schedule moving. Please respect the noted areas.

PETS

The IBT 2019 has adopted a **NO PETS** policy for this event. We ask all guests to please leave your pets at home. This follows our Insurance Policy which does not cover animal bites or related injuries. Service animals are generally exempt from this policy. Any service animal must be leashed and at no time permitted on the fields or player areas. We appreciate your cooperation.

TEAM TENTS

We love them and want everyone to enjoy the weekend. Please try to keep tents west of Fields 3 & 4 or east of Fields 1 & 2. This is where the most amount of open space will be. Please stay clear of team warm up areas and spectator areas adjacent to the fields.

TOURNAMENT RULES AND SPORTSMANSHIP

The tournament rules and our sportsmanship code of conduct will be posted at the Registration Tent and can be found in the coach's packet on www.cpyla.org/icebreaker. If you have a concern with anything during the course of the event, please contact your coach or tournament director first. They have been given instructions on how to address concerns with the tournament in the most effective manner.

MEDICAL PERSONNEL

We do have EMT's on site for the duration of the event. EMT's are only permitted to treat injuries that occur during the course of the event. They are not allowed to treat pre-existing injuries (i.e. they cannot tape your son's ankle). We want you to know in advance, so you can plan accordingly.

Last but not least...the schedule will be posted on TourneyMachine. Should we need to make any updates or provide notifications, we will do it through the notifications option on TourneyMachine. The main HQ tent will have a hard copy of the schedule should it go down during the course of the tournament.
