

COVID Safety Measures, Restrictions

The event will adhere to strict safety measures to allow basketball to be played, but also keep everyone safe as recommended by CDC and other guidelines.

- <u>Mandatory</u> masks by everyone, aside from players and officials participating. Coaches must wear masks during games
- Social distancing will be reminded and enforced as needed
- Players, fans, coaches can only attend their respective game, then the gym has to be cleared before the next game can begin warmups
- <u>All</u> persons entering will have temperature daily before receiving a bracelet.
- All persons will sign a waiver form (once for the event) also used for tracking. Minors and children will be signed for as well. A person only needs to sign once during the event
- Fans/players must wait until the preceding game's participants and fans to clear the respective Okun Fieldhouse court before entering
- Benches will be cleaned at halftime and between games. Benches will provide more spacing than usual
- Team huddles need to be spaced during halftime and postgame. Postgame huddles need to be held briefly
- Bleach seating will be extremely limited. Bringing own chairs is recommended
- Free throws will be limited to 1 for 2, or 1 for 3, to limit close, extended exposure of players
- Once your team's game is over please leave the building and return later.
- If you are sick or someone in your circle of friends and family are stay home.
- Individuals that are "at risk" need to stay home.
- The concession area will be open Please throw away your trash and do not congregate in the concessions area.
- No handshakes after games.

COVID-19 restrictions will apply as deemed by Kansas and Johnson County at that time.
