

Eligibility for the Elks Hoop Shoot is determined by the age that the contestant will be on:

## ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

If the contestant will be age 7 on <u>April 1, 2020</u>, she/he is <u>too young</u> to participate. If the contestant will be age 8 or 9 on <u>April 1, 2020</u>, she/he shoots in the 8 to 9 age-group. If the contestant will be age 10 or 11 on <u>April 1, 2020</u>, she/he shoots in the 10 to 11 age-group. If the contestant will be age 12 or 13 on <u>April 1, 2020</u>, she/he shoots in the 12 to 13 age-group. If the contestant will be age 14 on <u>April 1, 2020</u>, she/he is <u>too old</u> to participate.

Contestants who shoot in the incorrect age-group will be disqualified. No exceptions. Please share this information with all Hoop Shoot volunteers and contestant's parents.
