39th Annual MIT Basketball Tournament

March 14 & 15, 2020

Divisions	Boys/Girls Teams - Grades 3rd through 10th
Team Rankings	<p><u>Competitive team:</u> Any team that plays 10 or more games in a season plus tournaments. Team is coach/parent select or tryouts.</p> <p><u>Non-Competitive team:</u> Any team that plays less than 10 games in a season and a few tournaments. Team is assigned randomly (YMCA), by other organizations or by school.</p>
Players	<p>Teams must have a roster with a minimum of 8 players. No team will be accepted with fewer than 8 players. Players can compete in their grade level or above, and the team must compete at highest grade level. Player information must be correct. If incorrect information is submitted, player/team may be ineligible. Players cannot play on two teams in the same grade level. A player may play on 2 teams in different grade levels if they are listed on both rosters.</p>
Registration	<p>Registration fee for all teams is \$155 plus \$5 per player beyond 10 players. Entry forms must be completed and submitted to the Lincoln YMCA Youth Sports Office. Register by February 1 and save \$10. No Refunds. A \$75 fee will be retained if the tournament is cancelled due to weather. Special pricing available for organizations registering multiple teams.</p>
Registration Deadline	<p>Registration deadline is Friday, February 21, 2020. If the registration fee is not submitted with the entry form, the fee must be received prior to deadline. The YMCA reserves the right to refuse any player/team/coach. This refusal may be dependent on behavior of player/team/coach in previous YMCA tournaments/leagues.</p>
Rules	<p>Rules to be aware of include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Two 20 minute running clock halves. Clock Stops in the last minute of each half on all whistles.2. All teams must have numbered jerseys on at least the front or back.3. A team may only full court press or fast break up to a 20 point lead.4. 3rd grade teams will only be allowed to full court press in the final minute of the game.5. 3rd grade will play on a 9ft hoop. 4th-10th grades will play on a 10ft hoop.6. 3rd grade teams will play with a Junior size ball.7. Boys grades 4th-7th and Girls grades 4th-10th will play with an Intermediate size ball.8. Boys grades 8th-10th will play with a Regulation size ball.9. No bouncing of balls in hallways.
Sites	Various High Schools throughout Lincoln.
Game Times	<p>Game times are Saturday between 9:00 a.m.-6:30 p.m. and Sunday between 9:00 a.m.-6:30 p.m. The YMCA finds it necessary to schedule games on Sunday morning. Lincoln offers a variety of churches with convenient times and locations. We want all teams to be aware that some games will be scheduled on Sunday morning.</p>
Officials/Scorekeepers	<p>Two registered officials will be provided for all games. Each team will be required to provide a volunteer scorekeeper/timer. Electronic scoreboards will be used for all games.</p>
Admission	<p>Daily admission for Adults will be \$6 or a \$10 Adult Weekend Pass can be purchased. Daily admission for Seniors will be \$4 or a \$6 Senior Weekend Pass can be purchased. Daily admission for Child (5-15 years old) will be \$3 or a \$4 Child Weekend Pass can be purchased. Child (4 years old and under) is free admission. Admittance for player is free with laminated player pass. Player (in uniform) without a laminated player pass will be charged \$1 per day. Admittance for two coaches and one scorekeeper is free with laminated coach/scorekeeper pass.</p>
T-Shirts	Official tournament T-Shirts with addition of name and number on back of shirt will be available.
Pairings Information	<p>All teams will be scheduled for 3 games. MIT tournament information (schedules, rules, site locations, etc.) will be available online Thursday, March 4, 2020. MIT tournament will be using tourneymachine.com for schedules. A link will be posted on ymcalincoln.org All laminated passes will be mailed out to coaches on Thursday, March 5, 2020.</p>

The 39th Annual MIT Basketball Tournament will be played at High School sites in Lincoln, NE and at the Speedway Village Basketball Facility.

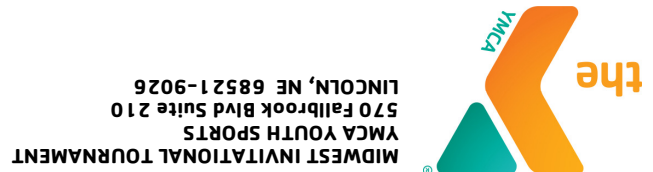
