



Team Guidelines

- Home plate meetings will need to be distanced and 6 feet apart. A coin toss will be used to determine home and away.
- Meetings at the pitcher's mound will be limited to the coach and pitcher. All other players must remain outside the circle.
- No seeds or spitting.
- No postgame handshakes...line up after game and wave.
- No sharing equipment.
- After the game, teams must leave the dugout. The head coach from each team is asked to spray the dugout with the provided sanitizer.
- Teams coming on to play the next game, should go to left or right field to warm up. After the dugouts are sanitized and allowed 5 minutes to dry, teams can enter and set up for their game.

Spectator Guidelines

- Spectators must be aware of social distancing. No gathering or groups of people. Families can sit together.
- If your team is in the 1st base dugout, please keep all fans spaced out down the 1st base line or in right field. If your team is in the 3rd base dugout, please keep all fans spaced out down the 3rd base line or left field.
- No spectators allowed directly behind home plate or behind the dugout.
- Bring your own chair.
- Only 2 spectators per player.
- When unable to maintain social distance, spectators must wear a face covering, so long as they are medically able to tolerate such covering.
