## 2020 Tournament Rules and Regulations

## All Tournament Games Will Be Played At:

Aurora Public Schools, Penner Athletic Courts, and Bremer Activity Center in Aurora
Each team may need to provide someone to assist with scorebook each game.
Players must play in their grade classification. Younger players can play up.
All players can only play on one team per tournament.
Grades may be combined if registration numbers are low.
28.5 sized basketballs and 10 foot rims in each division.

Warmups will be 5 minutes - can be adjusted based on schedule.
Halftime will be 3 minutes.

Concessions will be available.

## 1. Equipment

a. $4^{\text {th }}-8^{\text {th }}$ grade $-28.5^{\text {" }}$ basketball
2. Clock
a. Games will consist of (2) 16 minute running halves with 3 minutes between each half
b. Clock will stop on timeouts and the last 2 minutes of 2 nd half, if the game is 10 points or less

## 3. Time Outs

a. Each team will have 2 timeouts per game
4. Overtime
a. $1^{\text {st }}$ Overtime- 2 minute period
b. $2^{\text {nd }}$ Overtime-Next basket wins after $1^{\text {st }}$ overtime is exhausted

## 5. Team Fouls and Player Fouls

a. Bonus $-7^{\text {th }}$ team foul of the half; Double Bonus $-10^{\text {th }}$ team foul of the half
6. Free Throws
a. $4^{\text {th }}-8^{\text {th }}$ grade-Normal free throw rules apply

## 7. Pressing

a. 4th Grade No Pressing Beyond Halfcourt
b. $5^{\text {th }}-8^{\text {th }}$ grade-Pressing allowed during the entire game if the game is within 20 points (Losing team may press if down more than 20 points)
