RULE REMINDERS:

- AAU/USAV Rules will be follows
- Each team is allowed two (2) 30-second time-outs and twelve (12) substitutions per game. This applies to both pool and bracket play.
- Warm-up times are as follows: (4-4-2) Serve team in on the net first for 4 minutes then the receive team for 4 minutes. Then 2 minutes of shared time for serving. Warm-up time is for first matches only. No warm up time beyond that unless agreed upon by both teams.
- If a ball enters another court in the play area, **AND** interferes with the play, play is stopped and a replay is signaled.
- Boundaries for playing a ball that is off the court of play begin and end with the boundary line of the next court.
- A player may only play on one (1) team per day. Players may transfer to another team during the day only due to injury of another player. Once the transfer has been made the player cannot move back.
- Only players and coaches are allowed to sit on the bench or at the scoring table. Anyone in these areas must have an AAU card. **No cell phones, food or drinks at the scoring table.**
- Only water is allowed in the gym, **NO FOOD OR COOLERS ARE ALLOWED IN THE GYM.**

OFFICIATING

- Referees will be provided for all U14, U16, and U18 A divisions.
- All other age divisions will provide two (2) scorekeepers, one (1) scoreboard operator, two (2) referees, and two (2) line judges while they are the working team.
- Each team is to officiate the assigned games they are given and teams may be asked to officiate additional matches if the tournament is running behind or if conflicts arise with playing schedules.
- Coaches will be the R1 during all play, both pool play and bracket play. Players can be R2.
- Working teams please arrive on the court immediately following the previous match. It is your responsibility to keep the game moving. Do not leave after you have lost during bracket play, you will be the working team for the next match.

POOL PLAY

- Games for pool play are as follows:
 - Four (4) team pools – 2 sets to 21 cap at 23

BRACKET PLAY

- Games will be played the best 2 out of 3.
- There will be a cap in all rounds, except for the championship game
- 2 out of 3 to 25, cap at 27, 3rd game will be to 15, cap at 17
- Single elimination bracket
- The scoring for bracket play may change due to weather and time constrictions. This is at the discretion of the site director with possible input from coaches.

SPECIAL ANNOUNCEMENTS

*As of this writing, facial coverings are required by all spectators in the school district facilities. Players and coaches are not required to wear them if ACTIVELY playing. Please let your parents know this, Coaches will be responsible for ‘policing’ your parents. We will keep you apprised if this rule changes.

*NO outside chairs allowed in any of the facilities. Please let your parents know that as spectators, if your team is not currently playing, please exit the gym to allow space for other spectators.

*PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOURSELVES, and expect your players to do the same.

*Under NO circumstances is it acceptable to belittle a youth referee or line judge. “It is the obligation of the coaches, players, administrators, volunteers, and other representatives of the AAU to practice the highest principles of sportsmanship and to observe the ethics of competition. Good sportsmanship is defined as qualities of behavior, which are characterized by courtesy and genuine concern for others. The display of good sportsmanship is a statement of the individual’s understanding and commitment to fair play, ethical behavior, and integrity” – *AAU Code Handbook*. All AAU codes of conduct will be adhered to. Any violations of such may result in the removal from the gym and/or permanent removal from Wyoming AAU. Any issues regarding this or any other tournament issue should be directed to the site director first, then the Tournament Director. The Tournament Director will have final say on all matters related to the tournament.
