

POST COVID-19 TOURNAMENT PROCEDURES

- The tournament director, or designated employee or volunteer, shall screen each non-employee or volunteer prior to entering the premises. Additionally, the coach for each participant shall screen each of his or her participants prior to entering the premises. Any non-employee or volunteer who presents any symptom of COVID-19 shall be denied entry to the premises.
- Guests will be questioned if they are running a fever, recently sick or traveled outside of the country the last 30 days.
- Physical distancing standards must be applied, which always include remaining physically separated by 6 feet.
- All observers and participants who are waiting until their game is ready to start will need to practice social distancing outside the facility.
- It is recommended that observers and participants bring their own lawn chairs especially when bleacher seating is not available.
- In dugouts, discontinue use of water coolers that are provided by tournaments, parks or teams. Players should bring their own, personal cooler instead of using a team cooler. Players should plan on bringing an individual water bottle.
- In dugouts, only 5 players will be allowed at one time, there will be one player in the on-deck circle and one at the plate. All other players will be directed to the designated dugout areas.
- Minimize player contact by eliminating team/player handshakes and team/player high fives. No group prayers at plate meeting.
- Directors, players, umpires and spectators must adhere to the guidelines from CDC, state and local authorities, regarding potential state travel restrictions and stay-at-home orders.
- The managers meeting at home plate should be limited to one coach from each team plus the umpires. No players at plate meeting.
- Encourage parents to supply their players with antibacterial wipes and hand sanitizer for disinfecting shared playing equipment and cleaning hands between innings.
- Teams required to clean their dugout of all trash and other items after each game.

- Mound visits must maintain 6 ft. distance and base coaches must also maintain 6 ft. distances and cannot touch a runner or player on or off the field.
