

2020 NCAA Rules Apply:

Event Rules & Warnings:

- 1. Dives are allowed, and a new 10-yard sub box will be used as per 2020 NCAA Exceptions:
 - 1. There are NO Shot clocks of any kind ever.
 - 2. NO stick checks by refs unless requested by coach and any heads can be used still.
 - 3. Teams must clear midline in 20 seconds and touch it in the box in 10 seconds.
 - 4. Winning Team must 'Keep it in the Box' only in final 2 minutes of game if winning by 3 goals or less. 4 or more they do NOT have to keep it in. There is no stalling call allowed ever.

2. Game Format:

- 1. 2021-2024 Games are 4, 11-minute running quarters. No Time-Outs. No OT. Ties OK
- 2. All games have a 1-minute break for quarters. All penalties are running time starting on ref whistle.
- 3. Refs will keep penalty time, all games, quarters and game times will be kept by a central horn.
- 3. All players must submit a **REQUIRED WAIVER** to be eligible. Failure may result in team forfeit.
- 4. RULES RELATED TO INCLEMENT WEATHER:
- 5. There are no "rain dates". Assume that games will be played on their scheduled dates.
 - *NO REFUNDS* If inclement weather causes a game stoppage (i.e. lightning sighting) during the event, the following rules apply: Play will stop for until the Tournament Director deems the weather suitable for resuming, If the delay is substantial, Tournament HQ may make a decision to shorten all remaining games until the tournament is back on time.
- 6. All Injuries must be reported to the head trainer and/or training staff.

Please be aware that balls can and will fly from fields (shots or passes) and cause serious bodily harm. So, do not sit directly behind goals or within reach of errant shots that could travel up to 100 yards from a goal.
