

## Teams/Coaches

We are fortunate to be playing softball and to have our girls play in our beautiful state of Montana. PLEASE follow the social distancing guidelines this weekend at the tournament. We want to ensure that our girls can keep playing the rest of the summer in other counties. We know that other sporting tournaments in the state have been cancelled, and we recognize that other counties will be looking to see how our tournament is run and how well people abide by social distancing recommendations.

- DO NOT attend or come to the fields if you are sick or have any symptoms of COVID-19, or if you have had recent contact with a positive case.
- Maintain 6ft or more of distance from those that are NOT from your “home base”.
  - Home base; meaning those from your team that you have been around for weeks at the fields, or members of your household and family.
- Disinfectant is provided in the dugouts. Please wipe down surfaces before and after games.
- Encourage your girls to wash their hands and/or use hand sanitizers often.
- Do not crowd a team that is finishing a game. Allow room for teams to move and clean between games.
- We are asking teams to exit through the outfields in order to remove congestion from the entering and disbursing of teams and fans.
- No handshakes. Cheers instead!!
- No team captains at coin flips. Just coaches.
- We have added three porta potties and a handwashing station around the facility as well as our restrooms. Our restrooms will be cleaned frequently.
- Please encourage your fans to spread out all around the fields to watch games. Refrain from sitting in the bleachers. Bleachers will be roped off if necessary, but we would prefer them to be reserved for those with mobility issues.
- Please prepare your parents to know who came to watch their kiddos at the fields. If there is a positive case associated with the tournament or a particular game they will be asked who they were around and who they have close sustained contact with during the games.
- If someone is immunocompromised or elderly and wants to watch, there is plenty of room in the outfield and they can always wear a mask.
