

Dear Attendees,

We are excited to partner with Corrigan Sports Enterprises for the New England Cup this weekend, July 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>, 2020. We have provided some important facility information below in order to ensure a safe & fun weekend for all!

**Facility & Communicable Disease Waivers must be completed by any Player, Coach and Referee prior to any competition. Individuals who do not submit waivers will not be allowed to participate.**

**Players, coaches, and spectators must be temperature screened and receive a wristband. The wristband is required to remain at the complex. Anyone without a wristband will be asked to leave the complex. Temperature screens will be done at medical tents with red medical flags. There are two of these tents; one in each pod of fields.**

#### **COVID-19 Safety Guidelines for Attendance**

- **Coaches, Players, Parents MUST stay home if sick or experiencing any COVID-19 Symptoms**
- If a player has COVID-19 symptoms or has been in contact with a person with symptoms, in addition to staying home, please notify your coach and Morgan Cook @ Corrigan Sports
- Daily Health Check: Parents/Guardians are responsible for monitoring player temperature and symptoms prior to arrival. COVID-19 CDC-defined symptoms include cough, shortness of breath, or any of the following symptoms: Fever, Chills, Repeated shaking with chills, Muscle pain, Headache, Sore throat, New loss of taste or smell.
- Coaches, players, parents and staff are required to wear a mask for the duration of their time at FSA. This includes arrival, during the game, restroom use and departure.
- Masks are not required for players while actively participating in the game.
- All staff, parents and players must bring their own personal mask or face covering that completely covers the nose and mouth.

#### **Facility Rules**

- **NO PETS ANYWHERE ON THE PROPERTY**
  - **NO DOGS, CATS, ETC.** are allowed anywhere in or around the complex or fields. This includes all common areas and parking lots. If pets are seen on the premises, owners will be asked to leave the complex immediately and if pet is present near or around any field the game will be halted until the pet is removed to the parking area, but must be removed permanently from the complex as well. Properly marked and leashed service dogs are permitted at the complex but are not allowed within (10) yards of any field.
- Drones and Aerial video and photography and the use of HI-Pod (or similar) video camera equipment are not permitted at Farmington Sports Arena unless written approval is provided from FSA management

- (1) Adult spectator is allowed to accompany a player to the field and watch the game.
- Bleachers will be CLOSED during games. Spectators are allowed to bring their own chair.
- Teams are asked to forego post-game handshakes and team meetings. Please exit the field immediately at the end of the game so that our staff can prepare for the arrival of the next game.
- Indoor facility is closed
- Barbecue Grills not Permitted Anywhere on the Property
- Smoking, Gum Chewing, Sunflower Seeds, Glass Bottles are not permitted in the area of the field surface
- Alcohol is not permitted anywhere on the property
- Metal Spikes, Equipment Racks, Tents or any sharp object that may penetrate the surface are not permitted on the fields
- Bicycle, Scooters, Skateboards, Roller Blades or Golf Playing are not allowed on the fields
- No Parking on Grass Areas
- Please Dispose of Trash in Cans Provided
