Apex House Rules & Code of Conduct are established and enforced to help ensure guest safety and enjoyment while participating in activity at Apex.

NO SMOKING, CHEWING TOBACCO, E-CIGARETTES/VAPING, DRUGS

The health and wellness of our guests and athletes is our main priority at Apex. As such, Apex is a smoke/drug-free venue.

NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINK, TAILGATING, OR GLASS CONTAINERS (Excl. player water bottles and noted events)

Food and drinks are available at outdoor concessions (April 2020), the indoor Café (Coming Soon!), and the various vending machines located throughout Apex (Coming Soon!). Tailgating is not permitted; this includes but is not limited to food, beverages, tents, coolers, umbrellas, and tables. Glass containers are not permitted on site.

TRASH & RECYCLING

Please make sure you throw out trash or recyclables in the appropriate places around the facility. If you are seen littering, you will be given a warning; a second offense will result in a suspension from the grounds.

PARKING

Parking is permitted only in areas marked as parking spaces. Vehicles illegally parked will be towed at the owner's expense. Handicap parking spaces are reserved only for vehicles that have proper handicap identification. All other vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense.

LOST & FOUND

Apex is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged articles. In order to recover lost items, please visit the construction trailer located on the east side of the venue. Lost items will only be retained by Apex for a limited time.

SUPERVISION OF CHILDREN

Children must be supervised by a parent/guardian/coach at all times.

NO ANIMALS

No animals, with the exception of service animals, are permitted on site. Service animals should have proper paperwork/identification.

MEDICAL EMERGENCIES

In the event that a parent/guardian cannot be reached in an emergency, Apex reserves the right to seek emergency care for the injured guest, including ambulance assistance or hospital care, as may be deemed necessary under the circumstances at that time.

BEHAVIOR

- Conduct within the facility should be within the spirit of good sportsmanship at all times.
- Any conduct, including abusive language and/or gestures, racially insensitive remarks, damage to property or belongings, or any other conduct that reflects poorly on yourself or Apex is deemed to be unacceptable and will not be tolerated. This rule applies to all guests at all times when in or on the grounds of Apex.
- At no time shall spectators enter the fields or courts of play to speak with officials, coaches, or players. Spectators that violate this policy, may be suspended from the facility (suspension time based on severity).
- Team representatives are responsible for ensuring that guests observe all Apex rules, regulations, and policies.
- Apex reserves the right to expel any guest from Apex property without refund for misconduct committed upon the premises.

CODE OF CONDUCT (COACHES, GUESTS, PLAYERS, SPECTATORS)

Apex operates under a strict Code of Conduct. The purpose of the Code is to ensure that all those associated with Apex treat each other with dignity and respect. The Code of Conduct is a condition of membership for all guests. All members of Apex agree to abide by the Code of Conduct and to be subjected to the consequences of violating the Code. It is understood that by participating in any facility activity, that this Code of Conduct binds all guests and its validity as a matter of record and is not dependent upon physical signature. All enforcement decisions made by the managers of Apex are final and are not subject to petition or review. No refunds will be granted to those guests that are dismissed from Apex for violating the Code of Conduct.
