



ENTRANCE/TRAFFIC FLOW:

Guest entrance and exit is via the west gate entrance only (Mountain View Park entrance). East entrance will remain locked as a construction only area. As in previous mandates, spacing, capacity, and managing the flow of traffic in and out of the venue and in and out of fields of play continues to be an area of importance. **Coaches and event owners may be admitted a half hour prior to their booking; however, depending on daily scheduling, may or may not be able to get *on* the field until exactly the time of booking start. Parents/Players/Spectators will not be permitted to arrive any earlier than 15 minutes prior. All are asked to remain in cars until motioned for players to enter fields. Parents/Players/Spectators who arrive to the venue earlier than 15 minutes prior, will be re-routed to a nearby waiting area located at the Mountain View Park ballfield parking lots (.5 mi east of our west gate/main entrance).**

STAFFING/SCREENING:

Every car/visitor will be briefly stopped and welcomed by an Apex representative (or 2) at venue entrance. Visitors will be asked screening questions pertaining to symptoms, current health status, and the health of those you live with. Representatives will also provide you with a quick outline of where you can find sanitization stations around the venue, bathrooms, medical supplies, and staffing (identifiable by the neon yellow safety vests). If there is reason to believe a visitor's health is in question, we are required to turn away admittance into the venue. We ask that you take this brief screening seriously and answer honestly...in the best interest of your health and our other guests.

**Apex employees are sanitized, temperature checked, question screened, and required to wear masks at all times (and provided add'l PPE) **

** AED and basic first aid materials are available on site; we do not employ trainers outside of our internally run events or otherwise vetted. **

FIELDS are labeled with signage:

- *The first (most southern) field = 'Township Field.'*
- *The middle field = 'Apex 1.'*
- *The back (northern-most) field = 'Apex 2.'*

FIELD OPTIMIZATION:

Apex reserves the right to optimize its field use; meaning, from time to time we may jostle bookings between the 3 available fields. We will do our best to inform you of this jostle prior to arriving on site, but please be sure to check in with our Guest Services & Events Team Members upon arrival. To be

clear, we would not change the time of your rental, just the field assignment (to account for on-demand bookings taking shape around yours).

FIELD USE:

Please be courteous of other users by being on and off the field at your scheduled times. *If you need to move goals into place, please do so by lifting the entire goal, rather than dragging across the turf. Our Guest Services & Events team members are happy to assist.

FIELD NETTING: Each field is enclosed by 15' netting (back field is $\frac{3}{4}$ enclosed). Entry & exit points are marked and separated intentionally for traffic flow and distancing purposes – all located on the parking lot side of the fields.

WEATHER:

As a reminder (in your e-contracts), Apex runs lead with weather related cancellations. We will very rarely cancel for rain, as you're playing on state-of-the-art/well-draining turf fields. We will cancel for thunder and lightning in the area and any other weather conditions we deem inclement enough to negatively impact your experience, within reason of being athletes. We attempt to make these determinations at least 2 hours prior to your session and will contact your event's main point of contact – director(s) and signor(s) on the account. We will call, email, and/or text this contact. **Weather forecasts do tend to shift and change dramatically hour to hour here in Central Jersey. There may be times you arrive on site, but weather shifts to where we need to call it on site. We apologize in advance for any unforeseen inconveniences of this nature. We navigate reschedules/credits for any and all weather-related cancellations.

HAY AREAS/GRASS SEEDING: Please enter/exit the fields via paved pathways, as grass seeding is occurring surrounding the fields. As much as possible, please remain off the hayed/grass areas where the grass is attempting to grow. You'll notice the grass is long in length. Please excuse our mess; we are not able to mow it until the seed fully takes (should be longer for another 2-3 weeks).

PORT-O-JOHNS: We have 3 available (1 per field, located near each). As required, 1 is ADA compliant (the middle one); we ask that this bathroom be reserved for individuals who require it.

GARBAGE/RECYCLING: There are 4 receptacles per field – please help us keep Apex beautiful by properly dispensing of garbage and recycling in designated areas.

FOOD & BEVERAGE: No outside food or beverage is permitted aside from athlete water bottles; Apex on-site F&B service will begin later this Summer. Additionally, the venue does not permit tailgating, gum, or sunflower seeds.

FOOTWEAR: Sneakers, turfs, and cleats (no metal studs) are considered acceptable footwear for the turf fields. Apex does not permit heeled shoes and metal studded cleats.

Lastly, while our outdoor fields are open and ready for you, the remainder of our site is still something of an **active construction zone**. Our Venue Planning and Construction Teams have taken proper precautions to ensure a safe and hazard-free site by enclosing the construction areas in fencing and coned off areas of the parking lots. Please observe these boundaries and ensure that children are supervised at all times. **The eastern part of our venue is off-limits at this time.
