

Tournament Official Playing Rules, Waivers, Warnings & Venue Covid Guidelines

3 Games for every team minimum. 2021 & 2022 Divisions play a 4th game for a Championship. NCAA Rules apply except there are NO stick checks unless requested.

For face-offs, referee will place ball down on the line while FO middies stand back 6-10 feet. The referee will then back away and call, DOWN, then SET, and finally blow the WHISTLE.

All Games are four, 11-minute running quarters with Sudden Death Over-Time period.

Play OT without a clock until a goal. No Ties or Bravehearts.

1 Minute breaks between Quarters & Halftime.

One 30 second time-out allowed per game. One 30 second time-out allowed per OT.

Penalties are running time. Time-Outs STOP THE CLOCK!

In the case of extreme weather, MDLX Events reserves the right to shorten game times.

Tie-Breakers:

Record, Head-to-head, goals against common opponents, goals against, then goals for.

All parents of every player must submit for athletes to be eligible to play. Failure may result in team forfeit.

Warnings Flying lacrosse balls are moving up to 100MPH and can cause major bodily harm if they strike you. So, please always keep your eye on the field of play at all times.

DE Turf will implement the following basic operating policies and standards at each event:

- Team benches will not be provided.
- Water coolers will not be provided on fields for anyone.
- The Championship field (8) grandstand will be closed off.
- The Del-One Pavilion will be closed off.

- All spectators are required to wear masks or face covering. This includes players, coaches, referees, and event staff, when they are not on the playing field.
- Spectators should be socially distancing around venue unless they are from the same household.
- 4 handwashing stations have been installed at the complex that participants are encouraged to use.
- Social distancing signage will be spread out throughout the complex, as a reminder for all participants and spectators to follow.
- Restrooms will be opened and cleaned frequently throughout the day.
- Concessions will be operating using cashless payment only.
