

Beginning this weekend, June 25th 2020, we will be doing even more to try to insure the safety of teams, coaches, fans and staff during the Covid 19 pandemic. The following will be put in place at our park for the safety of all in attendance. If everyone (teams, coaches, fans) is prepared ahead of time as to the expectations for our park, the smoother things will go. Patience and understanding are a must, Thank you.

FANS

Six-foot social distancing between lawn chairs etc.

Handicapped seating will be taped off and not be accessible.

Grandstand seating area will be off limits. Lawn chairs only and must be separated at least six feet apart. Concrete walkway above each dugout as well as the grass hill above the left field line, may be utilized by fans. **NO FANS BEYOND TAPED OFF AREAS.**

NO SHADE TENTS ALLOWED IN STADIUM. Personal umbrellas are welcome.

Stadium Restrooms WILL NOT be in service. There is a small restroom located across the street near the pond.

There will be no concession items sold at the stadium. This includes Mid America.

Fans must clear the stadium immediately at the conclusion of the game, along with their belongings, to allow for disinfection of fan area. The quicker this can happen the quicker the next game can begin.

Fans arriving early for next game will be asked to wait until grandstands are disinfected following the previous game.

Fans arriving for the next game will be asked to wait outside the stadium before entering until disinfection of fan area is complete and previous teams/fans have exited the stadium. If fans already in the stadium are waiting for the second game of their DH to begin, they simply can move their belongings, chairs etc. to allow stadium staff to disinfect that area.

TEAMS/COACHES

No metal cleats. No exceptions.

NO SEEDS ALLOWED ANYWHERE IN THE STADIUM INCLUDES FAN AREAS.

No pre-game coaches/umpires meeting.

No post game handshakes.

No post game team meetings or conditioning.

No water coolers will be provided in dugouts. Players are responsible for their own personal water bottle.

Hand sanitizer in each dugout.

Stadium restrooms WILL NOT be in service. There is a restroom located across the street near the pond.

TEAMS ARRIVING FOR THE NEXT GAME WILL BE ASKED TO WAIT IN THE "TEAM HOLDING AREA" ABOVE THE 3B BULLPEN UNTIL SIGNALLED IT IS TIME TO COME ONTO THE FIELD BY STADIUM STAFF. DO NOT CONGEGATE NEAR ANY DUGOUT OR IN THE FAN AREA WHEN WAITING.

ALL TEAMS WILL ENTER THE FIELD VIA THE UTILITY GATES

Batting Cages, turf area down the RFL and the softball field area will not be available for any pre-game warm up. Teams are asked to warm up only when on the field.

Teams finishing play must exit the dugout immediately following their game so stadium staff can disinfect the dugouts for the next game. The quicker they can exit the quicker other teams can be let onto the field to warm up. **POST GAME MEETINGS MUST HAPPEN OUTSIDE THE STADIUM.**

I WOULD RECOMMEND TEAMS NOT ARRIVE EARLY SINCE PRE-GAME WARM-UP WILL ONLY TAKE PLACE WHEN ON THE FIELD.

In case of a previous rain storm, warm will take place only on the turf area. OF grass will be used during game only. This will be game day decision.

If teams wish to take pre-game groundballs infielders are asked to position themselves in foul territory down each line next to the bullpens.

Coaches must fungo from the turf only.

STAFF/TOURNEY

VSports will not provide a gate attendant. If in-person gate is needed, Mid America will provide that staff person or collect gate from each team pre-tourney.

Maximum 5 games per day, unless otherwise cleared

2.5 hours scheduled between games to allow more time for disinfection of dugouts and fan area before teams will be allowed onto the field. Game times will be 8:00, 10:30, 1:00, 3:30, (6:00 if needed)
