# **Tiebreaker Rules for Each Division**

#### • Tie Breaker Rules

- Within Pools Best Record, Head to Head, Highest Point Differentials Sum, Highest Points Scored Sum, Lowest Points Allowed Sum
- Within Division <u>Pool Place</u>, Best Record, Head to Head, Highest Point Differentials Sum, Highest Points Scored Sum, Lowest Points Allowed Sum
- o Max Score Differential Per Game 25 pts

### 10U Boys (5 teams)

- Each team plays each other
- o Division winner will be determined using Tie Breaker Rules

# 12U Boys (8 teams)

• This division is an 8-team bracket with teams advancing to Championship, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 7<sup>th</sup> Place games. *No Tie breaker rules needed.* 

### • 14U Boys Silver and 14U Girls (5 teams each)

- o Each team plays each other
- o Top two teams determined using Tie Breaker Rules will play in a Championship game

# 14U and 16U Boys Gold (8 teams each)

- Play in games seed an 8-team bracket
- o Teams advance to Championship, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 7<sup>th</sup> Place games. *No Tie breaker rules needed.*

## 16U Boys Silver (9 teams)

- o Three pools where teams play 2 games each
- Tie Breaker Rules will seed a 4-team bracket that plays out to Championship and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place games. <u>Exception</u>: During the seeding of this bracket, matchups may be adjusted to avoid a rematch of an earlier pool game.
- o Tie Breaker Rules will seed a 5-team consolation bracket that plays out to 5<sup>th</sup> and 7th Place.

#### 18U Boys Silver and 16U Girls (6 teams each)

- Two pools where teams play 2 games each
- Tie Breaker Rules will seed a 6-team bracket that plays out to Championship, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> Place games

#### 18U Boys Gold (4 teams)

- o Each team plays each other
- o Top two teams determined using Tie Breaker Rules will play in a Championship game.
- Bottom two teams determined using Tie Breaker Rules will play in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Place game

# 10U Girls (2 teams)

- Each team plays each other
- Division winner will be determined using Tie Breaker Rules

#### 12U Girls (6 teams each)

- Two pools where teams play 2 games each
- o Tie Breaker Rules will seed a 4-team bracket that plays out to a Championship game
- o Bottom two teams will play in the 5<sup>th</sup> Place game

#### 18U Girls (7 teams)

- Two pools where teams play 2 games each
- $_{\circ}$  The bracket will be seeded using the Tie Breaker Rules <u>within a Division</u> with the #1 seed getting a 1<sup>st</sup> round bye
- The three 1<sup>st</sup> round bracket games will be seeded using the Tie Breaker Rules within a
  <u>Division. Exception:</u> During the seeding process, an adjustment may be made to the 1<sup>st</sup>
  round bracket games to avoid a rematch of an earlier pool game.
