



Tournament COVID-19 Guidelines

As we navigate through our current environment, we are committed to providing you an excellent experience for your event. Please read through these guidelines carefully. If you have any questions, do not hesitate to reach out to us prior to your arrival for your event.

- ◆ Everyone **MUST** wear a mask upon entering the facility.
 1. Players on the floor are not required to wear a mask
 2. Spectators must wear a mask in the stands.
 3. Spectators/Players walking in the hallways/café must wear a mask.
- ◆ Water fountains will not be available— Our café/vending machines will be open with food and beverages available for purchase. **NO OUTSIDE FOOD** is allowed. Teams are not allowed to bring coolers into the facility.
- ◆ Players can bring bottled water on the court. Each team **MUST** clean all drink bottles and trash from the bench at the end of each game.
- ◆ We utilize a separate check in/entrance process for teams to avoid congestion in the entry. Team entrance will take place on the **WEST** side of the facility (between courts 5/6). We will set up a table so please make arrangements to staff.
- ◆ Teams **WILL NOT** be allowed to meet/congregate in the hallways/café after a game. Please advise them.

HOW YOU CAN ASSIST US TO MAKE THIS PROCESS EASIER:

- ◆ Inform your Coaches, players, and parents: If you feel sick, **STAY AT HOME**. You need to conduct temperature checks at the team check in **AND** spectators as they enter.
- ◆ Teams must come dressed to play; bathrooms will not be available as a changing area.
- ◆ Encourage the washing of hands and provide sanitizer at each court for your teams.
- ◆ Before each game, sanitize the equipment (balls). Encourage teams to bring sanitizers with them.
- ◆ Assist us in notifying teams regarding the mask policy. If they enter without a mask they will have to purchase a mask (either sold by MI3 Center or by your organization).

Our staff works to ensure our facility is sanitized frequently. We have sanitizers throughout the facility. We also will monitor that local guidelines are followed. We will appreciate your cooperation in ensuring your teams and spectators do the same.

As the COVID-19 situation and county guidelines are constantly changing, MI3 Center will continue to monitor to ensure we are in compliance. We will notify you if changes will affect the integrity of your event.
