

WEST PLAINS PARKS AND RECREATION YOUTH COVID-19 RULES AND REGULATIONS

We know that during this time of uncertainty, it is extremely important for us to all do our part in keeping everyone safe. The Parks office has put together the following guidelines based on City, County and other organizations across the Nation on how we will conduct the business of youth basketball and volleyball in our facility. These processes will help insure that we are doing our part to keep all the teams and spectators as safe as we can. We have added Hand Sanitizer dispensers in the common area. In addition to the following, our officials and employees will also be helping during games to sanitize properly and we will rely on teams and spectators to help in this process by following the below guidelines.

Our main goal is to make sure that we are helping to keep everyone safe that is coming through our doors, we have done everything possible to make sure that we are following the guidelines based on the information that we have been given. The following guidelines are based on the information that has been given and will become effective Oct. 12, 2020.

Between game procedures

During Games

- No handshakes, high fives, each team can yell good game to the other team at the end of the game.
- During timeouts - players should sit on the bench or stand near - no huddle up, keep distance

Spectators

- Number of spectators per team - 40 (teams will need decide before that time comes Coaches will be given 40 vouchers per week spectators must have voucher to enter game and pay admission) *players and coaches do NOT count, this is only those that will be sitting and watching the games at the Jimmie Carroll Sports Complex or Civic Center
- Water fountains will be marked off - please bring separate water bottles for each player.
- We will provide basketballs & Volleyballs – No Outside balls
- Refrain from bringing siblings and young children, if children do come they have to sit on the bleachers with the parent/adult - no running around common area.
- Before games there will be a red light and green light outside the complex each game will be spaced out 1 hour for basketball and 45 mins for volleyball – teams may not enter until other game is finished.
- once game is finished players will exit the back door to the parking lot – teams and spectators will enter thru front doors.
- after each game bleachers will be sanitized before next team comes in.
- all fans must wear mask at all times, players and coaches must wear mask until they are on their bench, then they can be removed.
- Spectators will need to sit either on the home or away bench at the sports complex which ever your team is on home team fans will sit in home section.
- Youth Volleyball – if a team wins both 1st and 2nd set and a 3rd set is not needed it will not be played. If 3rd set is needed it will be to 15 and/or 10 mins.

- Every one that uses a voucher will pay \$2.00 gate for entry. No bills larger than \$20 will be excepted.

- Jimmie Carroll Sports complex seating we have 3 rows of bleachers middle row can not be sat on. Please space accordingly.

Concessions will be limited

No pizza, No popcorn, No hot dogs, No pretzels

No concession at the Civic Center. No outside food at the Civic Center

We will have bottle drinks, pre-packaged foods only - please plan accordingly.
