Eagan Run-N-Gun Wildcat Classic Frequently Asked Questions

- How many fans are allowed into a game per team? 10 spectators are allowed in with 2 coaches, or 9 spectators if there are 3 coaches. Official scorekeeper is included in that count for the home team.
- Can I go to one game and have someone else go to the next one in my place? Yes, we will not have wristbands, each team will be allowed the number above, but actual people can change from game to game.
- Will there be chairs for spectators? Due to the rules of each of our venues, this will vary. Games at Eagan Community Center will have chairs or bleachers for spectators, Apple Valley Community Center will only provide chairs for those in need, and Hope Fieldhouse will allow outside chairs to be brought in (they must not damage the floor).
- **Do you have a COVID policy for the tournament?** Yes, it can be found on the tournament website, as well as in the Tourney Machine App.
- What do I do when I get there? You will need to gather at a designated location outside the building with the rest of your team. Players and coaches will be escorted in 10 minutes prior to the game, spectators will be escorted in 2 minutes prior to the game. Please download the Twitter app and follow @EaganRunNGun to get updates on games prior to yours.
- What is the mask policy? Masks are required for spectators 100% of the time, coaches only remove from tip-off until time expires, and for players must wear them when they are not in the game or warming up on the court.
- Will the tournament have food available? Due to COVID protocols, we will not have concessions, however food trucks will be staged at each location. The food trucks are:
 - o ECC Xstream Cuisine- Caribbean
 - AVCC Cafe Cairo Greek/Egyptian
 - Hope Fieldhouse Sandy's Grill and Italian Ice
- How do we know if we are the home team (and therefore need to provide an official scorekeeper)? Your team will be listed first in a pool game matchup, or your team will appear at the top of a bracket game.
- What happens if I arrive late? You will need to wait outside the door until your escort is done seating the teams and parents. Your escort will come back out to get you.
- What would happen if someone on another team tests positive for COVID? As you enter your game, each team will be required to provide a point person. It could be a coach, manager or parent. If we are notified of a positive test, we will contract trace that team with other teams, referees and volunteers for those games, and that contact person would be notified. That person is responsible for understanding who is in attendance for those games for your team, so the proper follow up notifications can be issued.
