

Future Starz Tournament Series Return To Play Policies

• A Future Starz Tournament official will enforce the below Return to Play Policies

Health Monitoring:

- Daily self-evaluated wellness screenings need to be completed by all guests and event attendees prior to entering the venue. Guests experiencing COVID-19 symptoms while traveling should contact a local health care facility immediately and are not permitted to attend the event.
- If you have been sick in the last week or have been in contact with anyone who
 has had COVID-19 or has been sick in the last 14 days you are prohibited from
 attending the event.

Hand Washing:

 We recommend everyone wash their hands often, and when soap and water is not available, please utilize hand sanitizer.

• Facial Masks:

 We recommend event attendees to wear facial masks when social distancing is not possible

• Social Distancing:

Please maintain at least six feet between you and others.

Pre-Game:

 All participants in the home plate meeting must maintain at least six feet of social distance

College coaches:

- College coaches are recommended to wear masks.
- College coaches will stand/sit six feet apart from each other in the designated areas

• Team coaches:

Team coaches are recommended to wear masks.

• Umpires:

Umpires are recommended to wear masks.

Spectators:

 Spectators are recommended to wear masks and must stand/sit at least six feet from one another.

Players:

- Players are recommended to wear masks when not on the playing field
- Use of dugouts is permitted during games only
- Sunflower seeds, spitting, gum, licking fingers and chewing tobacco are prohibited.

Staff:

- Staff members are required to wear facial masks.
- Staff are to sit/stand in designated areas

• Sportsmanship:

o Post-game handshakes and/or interaction between teams is prohibited.



• Teams:

- Teams to play next will be provided designated areas for player warm-ups that provide for necessary social distancing
- When games end, no post-game talks at the field are permitted; fans and players must leave the playing area.
- The team to play next must remain in their designated warm up area until the prior team is completely out of the dugout..

• Food & Beverage:

- Sunflower seeds, spitting, gum, licking fingers and chewing tobacco are prohibited.
- Concession stands are not permitted

• Future Updates:

O Throughout the season as medical and governmental guidance changes, our Return to Play policies will continue to evolve. All updates will be communicated to participants in advance of their event. Return To Play Policies may change if the controlling entity of a venue used for an event enforces alternate Return To Play Policies. You will be made aware of these alterations through a message from TourneyMachine.
