

# 2021 NJ Heat Tournament Rules of Play



#### Please note:

- No spectators are allowed to congregate or watch game from behind the dugout or backstop and will be asked to relocate if needed.
- By participating in this event, Coaches acknowledge and verify that their teams are in COVID compliance and that all players and coaches:
  - Have not presented a fever over 99.5 degrees or higher over last 48 hours
  - Have not been in contact with (6' or less for 15 minutes or more within 24 hours) with someone that has tested positive for COVID or waiting for results of a COVID test due to showing symptoms
  - Have not had any COVID related symptoms over the past 48 hours

#### **TEAM CHECK IN**

• The only Team Check-In requirement is to verify that your team insurance is in force. A copy of your insurance can be emailed to <a href="mailto:njheatfastpitch@gmail.com">njheatfastpitch@gmail.com</a> before 6:00 PM on the Friday before the event. If you email to us, there is no check-in required the morning of the event. If a copy is not emailed, please check your team in prior to your 1st game at the table in the common area.

#### **USA Softball Rules Apply**

## Safety Rules as required by USA Softball.

• ALL BATTING HELMETS MUST HAVE APPROVED FACEMASKS.

### **Courtesy Runners**

- Courtesy Runner should be used at all times for Pitchers and Catchers to speed up play
  - Courtesy Runner must come from the bench (any player not in game) or last batted out (in that order).
  - Courtesy Runner(s) must be different for pitcher and catcher within the same inning.

# **Player Line Ups:**

- Teams may choose to bat entire roster if they would like to. There will be unlimited defensive substitutions if batting entire line-up.
- DP/FLEX rule may also be used in addition to the EP above and will follow USA Softball rules regarding such.

#### Game Length & Time:

- Pool Games home team decided by coin flip. The team that traveled furthest distance will call.
- Bracket Games home team decided by seeding. If Championship game is between teams with same Pool seeding, then home team will be determined by Division Seeding.
- 7 inning games for 12U/14U/16U/18U
- No new inning may begin after 1 hr 20 / No time limit on Championship Games
- Saturday games can end in a tie. If time permits use International Tie Breaker.

#### **Run Ahead Rule:**

12U/14U/16U/18U - 12 runs after 3 innings; 10 runs after 4, 8 runs after 5

## **Sunday Seeding**

Seeding will be based on the following:

- Total Points (2 points for win, 1 point for ties, 0 points for loss)
- In the event of a tie:
  - Head to head if only 2 teams tied
    - Determined within Pool if Pool standings are used for bracket play
    - Determined by division if Pool standings ARE NOT used for bracket play
  - Total runs allowed
  - Total runs scored
  - Run differential
  - Coin Flip
